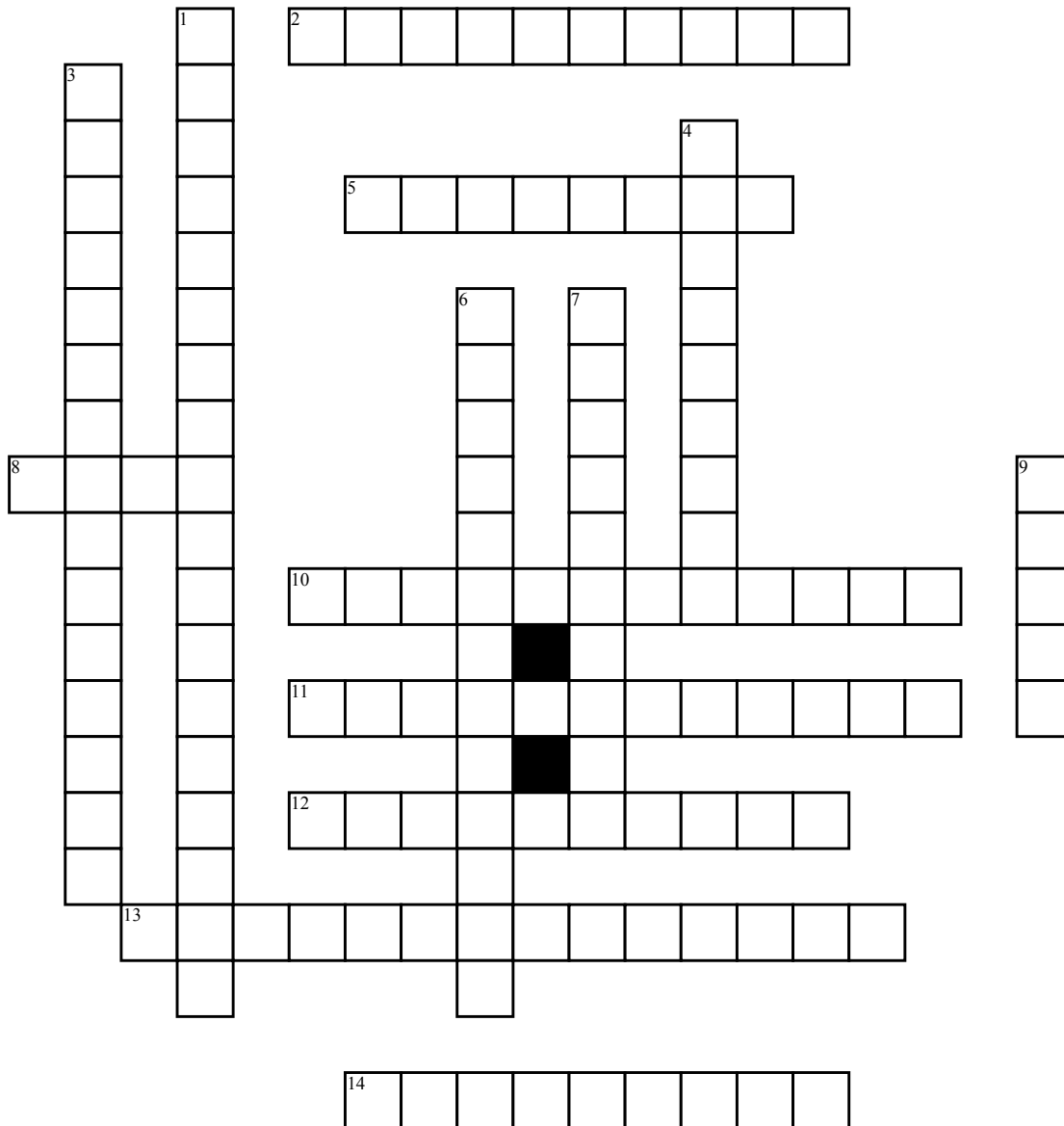

13. An inflammation or infection in one or more small pouches in the digestive tract.

14. A mass of unusual cells growing in a bone. Most bone tumors aren't cancerous.

3. An acute inflammation or irritation of the bronchi.

4. A form of indigestion felt as a burning sensation in the chest, caused by acid regurgitation into the esophagus.

7. A cancerous or noncancerous mass or growth of abnormal cells in the brain.

9. An inflammatory disease caused when the immune system attacks its own tissues.
