

- **10.** Male swine that has not been castrated
- **11.** Male swine castrated while young

- **12.** Male sheep or goat that has been castrated before reaching maturity
- **13.** Male bovine of any age that has not been castrated
- **14.** A male bovine animal that was castrated before reaching maturity Cow
- **17.** Female horse under three years of age
- **19.** Young horse, donkey or mule of either gender up to one year of age
- **21.** Mature female horse four years of age or older
- **22.** Older female swine that has farrowed or shows signs of pregnancy
