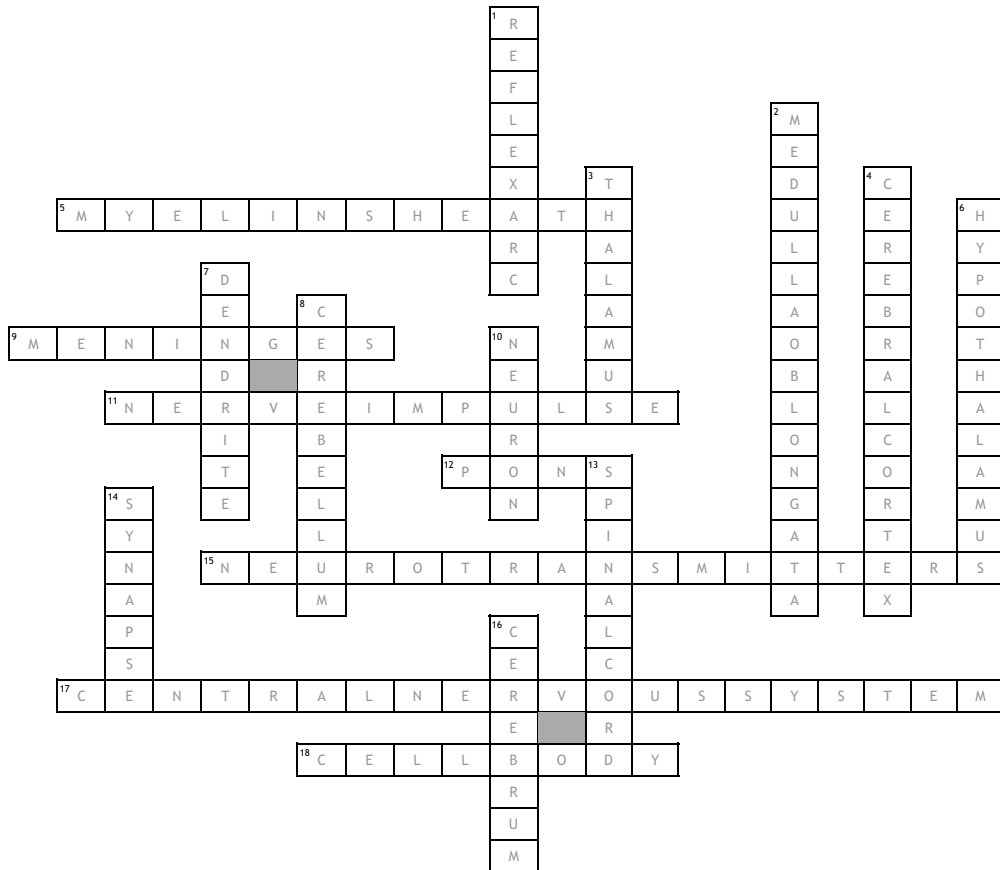

1. The series of neurons that produces a single reaction in response to a stimulus
2. Part of the brain; Relay center between spinal cord and brain; reflex center
3. The brain region that receives general sensations and relays impulses to a parietal lobe
4. The gray matter of the cerebrum
6. The region of the brain that controls involuntary activities
7. Part of the neuron that receives nerve impulses and transmits them toward the cell body
8. Part of the brain that monitors and adjusts body activities
10. The functional unit of the nervous system. The cell that receives and distributes nerve impulses.
13. The nervous tissue that conducts messages between the brain and the peripheral body parts
14. The junction between the axon and dendrite
16. The part of the brain containing motor and sensory centers: controls voluntary movement
