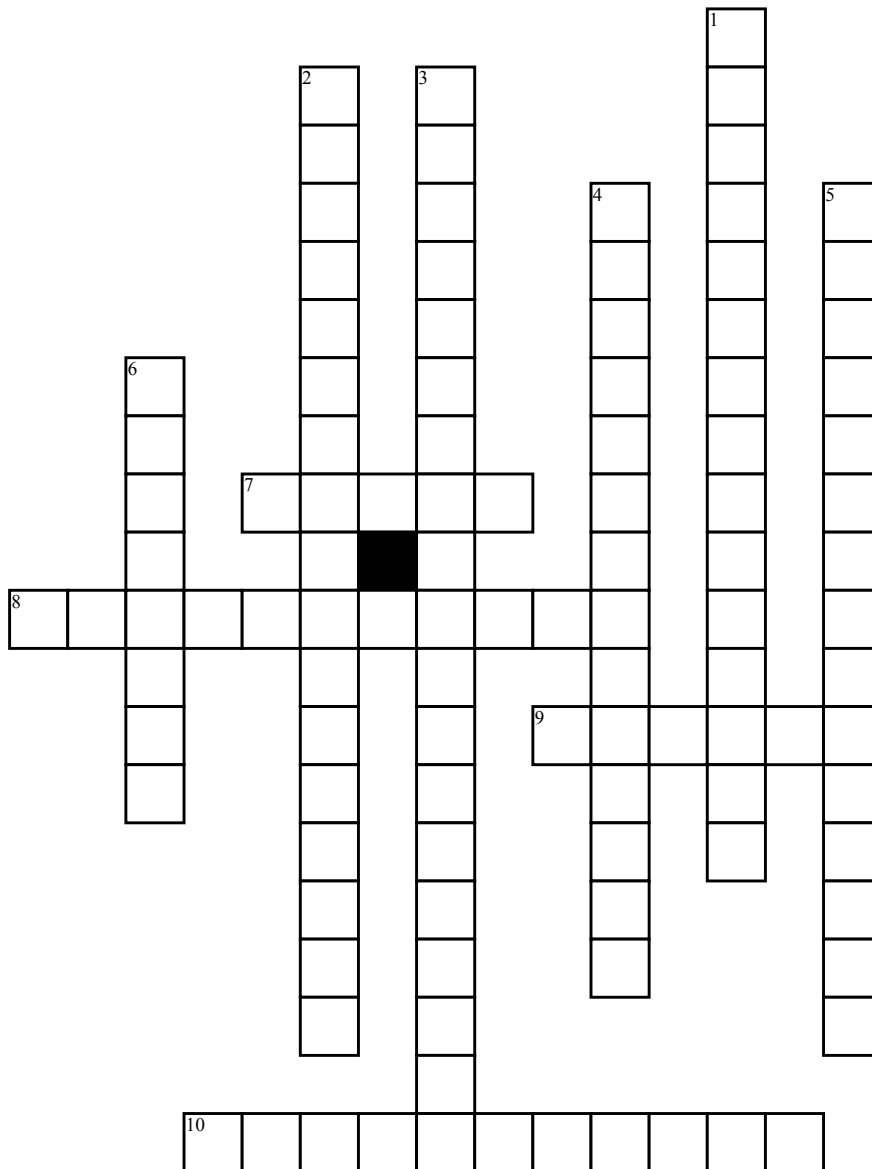

1. A local governmental unit created for a single purpose, such as water distribution.
 2. A municipal government in which the mayor has the power to perform the executive functions of government.
 3. A form of municipal governance in which there is an elected executive and an elected legislature.
 4. Political jurisdictions, such as cities, villages, or towns, incorporated under state law to provide governance to defined geographical areas; they are more compact and more densely populated than counties.
 5. A municipal government in which the mayor lacks true executive powers, such as the ability to veto council decisions or appoint department heads.
 6. Geographical subdivisions of state government.
