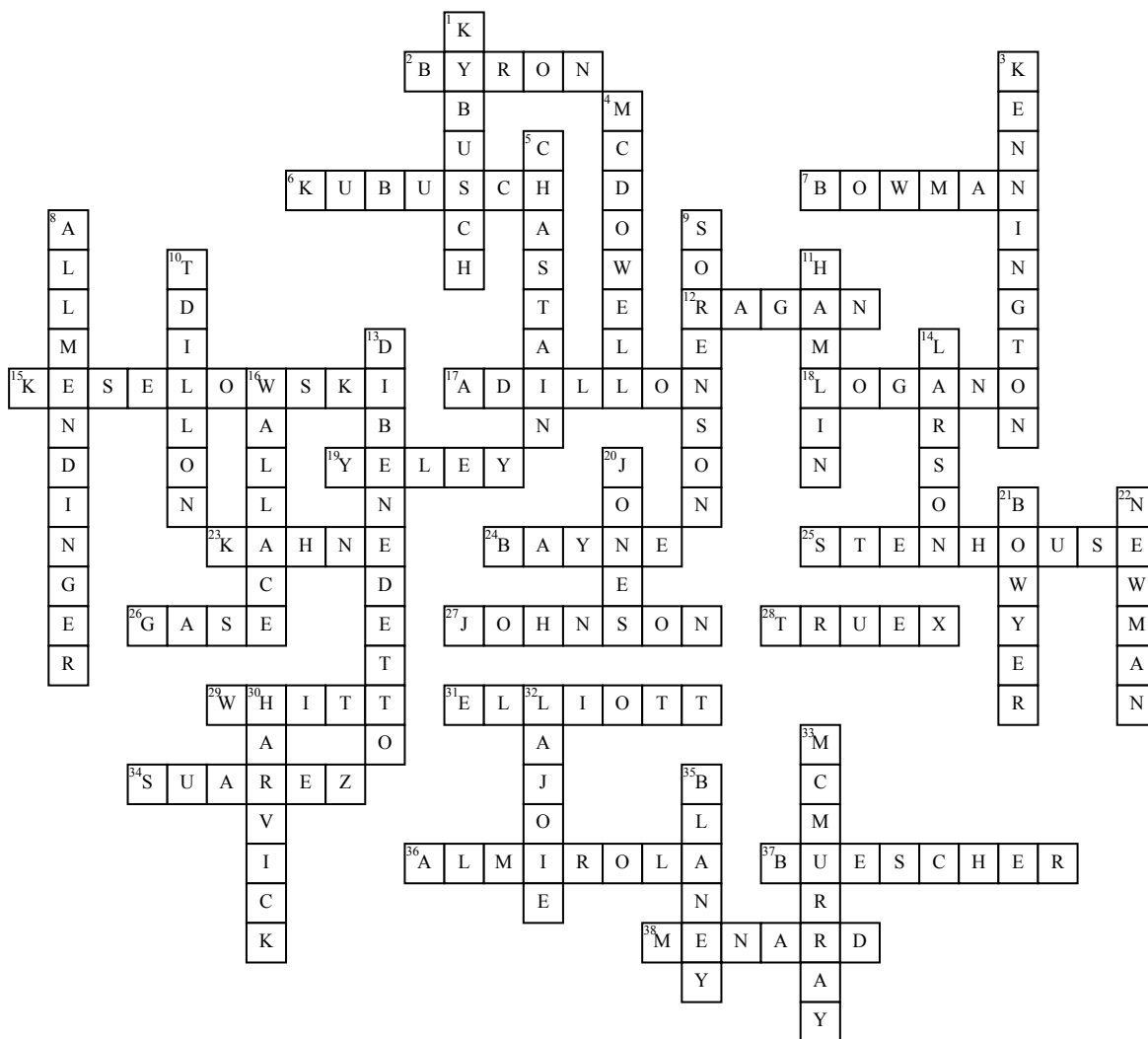

 - 3. Canadian born driver, usually seen only at the Daytona 500
 - 4. Tucson, Arizona native, drives for Front Row Motorsports
 - 5. Watermelon farmer from Florida, has 1 career Xfinity win
 - 8. 1 career win in the Cup Series at Watkins Glen
 - 9. Journey man driver, formerly with Chip Ganassi Racing
 - 10. Brother of one of the other drivers, Germain Racing
 - 11. First driver to ever make the Chase as a rookie in 2006
 - 13. Popular driver in an underfunded car, moving to Levine Family Racing next year
 - 14. 5 time winner in Cup Series, Chip Ganassi Racing
 - 16. Mobile, Alabama native, Richard Petty Motorsports
 - 20. Found by Kyle Busch at the Snowball Derby in Florida
 - 21. 8 career wins, driver for Stewart-Haas Racing
 - 22. 2008 Daytona 500 Champion with Team Penske
 - 30. Replaced Dale Earnhardt Sr. after his passing
 - 32. Known for wrecking a lot, popular on social media
 - 33. Won his first race in his second ever NASCAR Cup start
 - 35. Second generation racer, newest member to Team Penske
