

3. A sponge-like formation of rock, sand or gravel that holds water

8. A channel dug into an aquifer to reach groundwater

9. Relatively pure water, with few dissolved salts
10. Having spaces or pores that allow water and other substances to pass through

11. All of the land area that supplies water to a particular river system

12. Water that flows over land and collects in a stream or river

<u>Down</u>

1. Boundary between the zone of aeration and zone of saturation in an aquifer

2. Freshwater found below the Earth's surface

4. A network of interconnected streams and rivers

5. Not allowing water and other substances to pass through

6. An area where surface water soaks into the ground and reaches an aquifer

7. Freshwater found on the Earth's surface
