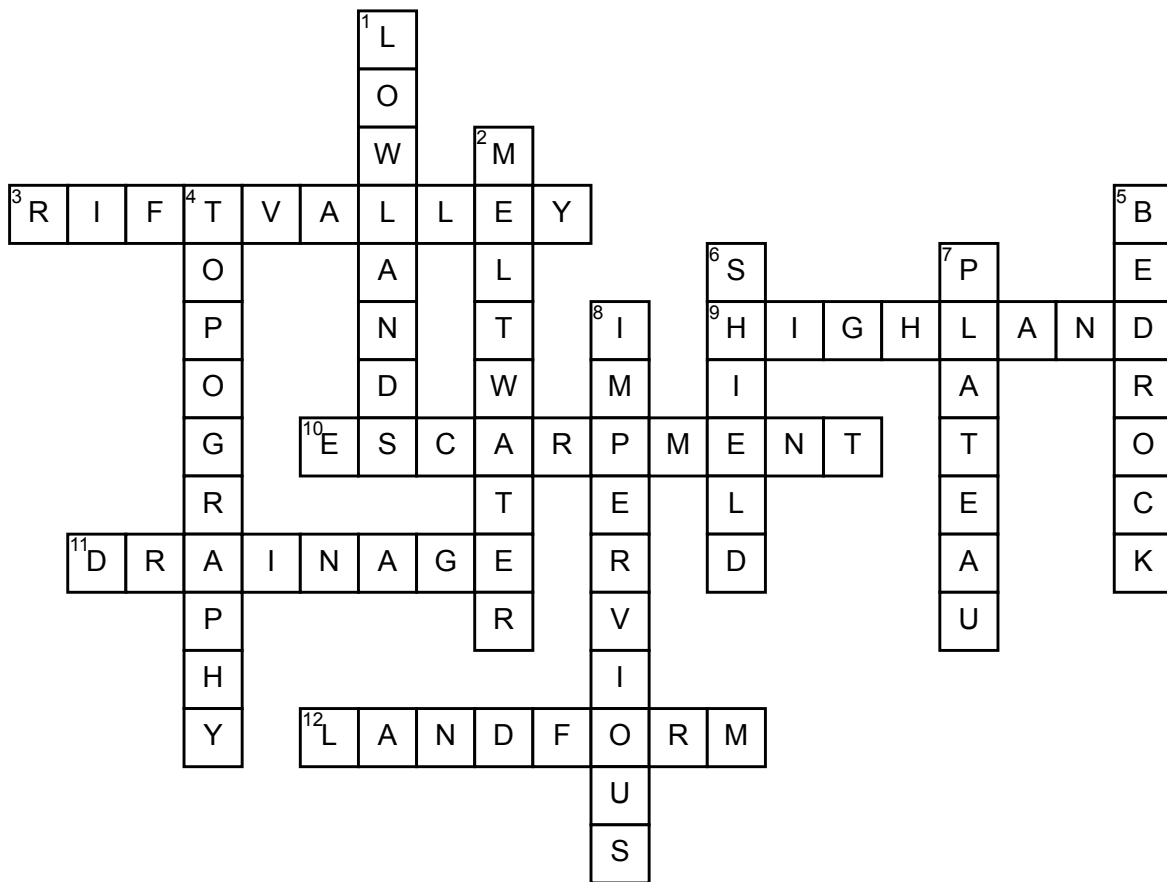


# Landforms



## Across

**3.** Created when the portion of land between two faults drop down

**9.** Area of high elevations containing mountains and plateaus

**10.** Steep cliff formed by erosion or faulting

**11.** Process whereby water is removed from an area

**12.** Natural feature on earth's surface

## Down

**1.** Area of low elevation containing plains and hills

**2.** Melting of glacier/ice

**4.** Natural and human features of the landscape

**5.** Solid rock beneath the soil

**6.** Large area of Precambrian rock that forms the core of a continent

**7.** Elevated flat area

**8.** Quality of a substance that does not allow fluids or gases to pass through it
