

- **2.** Watch your video on the timeline/sequence as you "scrub" the timeline or play it from start to finish.
- **3.** Used to visually monitor the level of audio in your project.
- **7.** This tool is used to split a clip.
- **9.** Used to zoom in and out (hold alt) on the timeline.
- **11.** Button will allow you to export a still image from anywhere on your timeline
- **13.** Used to change the cut point between two clips. It allows you to adjust In/Out points of two adjacent clips in one step.

- **14.** Button hides & shows each video track like layers in PS.
- **15.** You control or adjust your effects. It is often nested under the Source monitor.
- **17.** You will find your effects and transitions here. It is often nested under the Project Panel.
- **19.** What is the file extension name for raw Premiere projects?
- **20.** This is where you will build your video sequences.

Down

- **1.** You preview and trim your clips during the rough cut process.
- **4.** You import and organize all your media, titles and sequences.

- **5.** This is where you access the tools.
- **6.** Used to change the speed (slow down or speed up) of a clip.
- **8.** Used to select, move clips and trim In/Out points of clips on the timeline.
- **10.** Used to change In or Out point of a clip on timeline & then automatically rippling all the other clips on the timeline with one step.
- **12.** This button will play the video (I usually use the spacebar instead)
- **16.** Used to create keyframes on the audio rubber band
- **18.** This tool is used to slide your view of the timeline.
