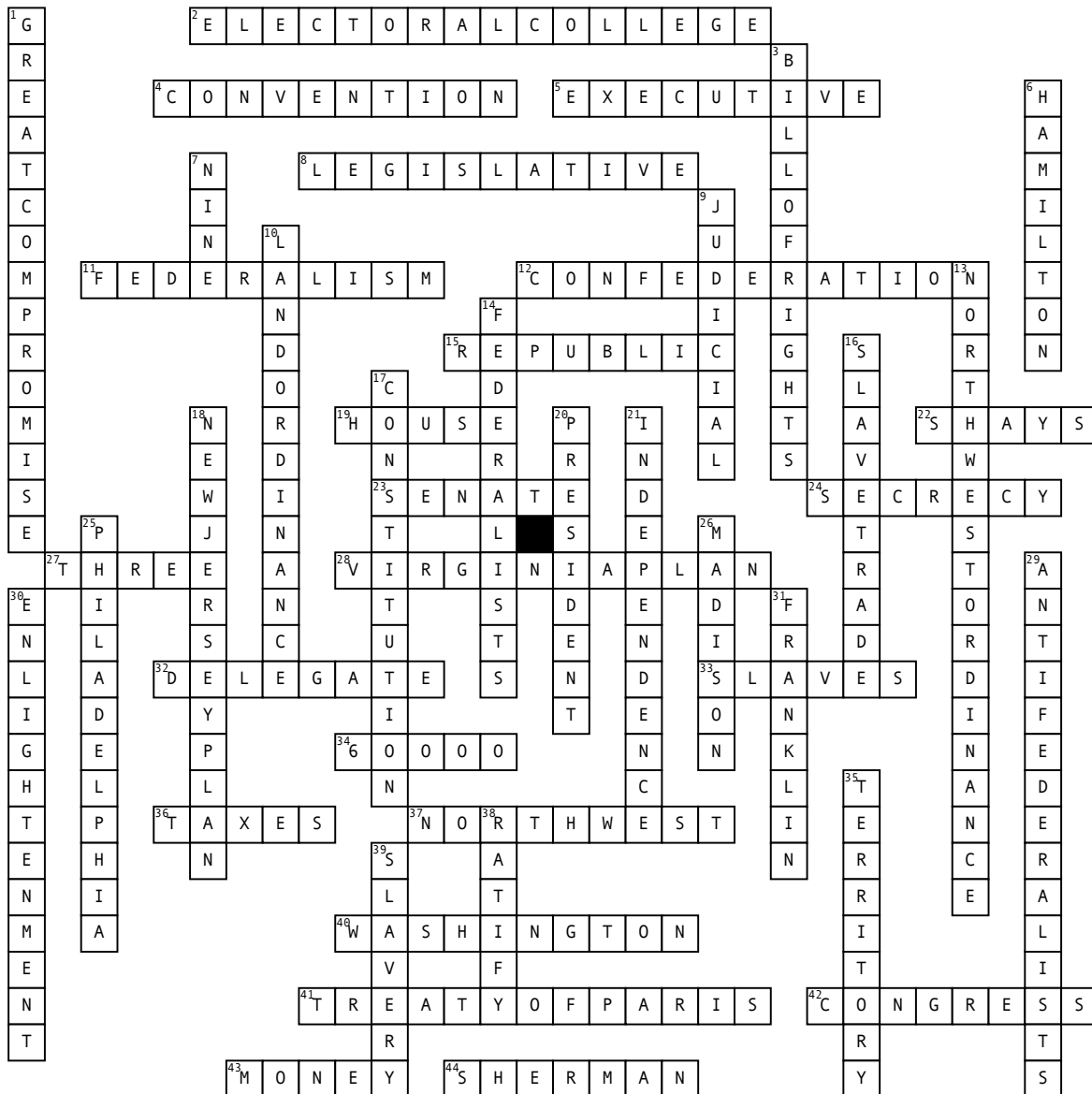

 - A loose alliance of states with similar interests
 - A form of government with elected representatives who rule
 - Part of Congress in which the number of representatives for each state is based on population size (____ of Representatives)
 - Last name of a Massachusetts farmer who led a rebellion against the local government
 - Name of the part of Congress in which each state gets two representatives
 - The convention was bound by the rule of _____ to keep private all information about what they were doing
 - The framers decided to compromise by counting every 5 slaves living in a state as _____ people (spell out the #)
 - Plan in which Congressional representation would be based on the population size of each state
 - Term for a person sent to represent their state at the gathering to revise the Articles
 - Group of people about which there was disagreement over how to count them towards a state's population
 - Number of citizens needed for a territory to apply to become a state
 - The US government's inability to impose _____ caused it to have major financial issues early in its existence
 - The land between Canada, the Mississippi River, the Ohio River, and the original 13 states (____ Territory)
 - President of the Constitutional Convention (last name only)
 - Agreement which caused the US to gain the rest of the land east of the Mississippi River
 - The name of the lawmaking body of the US government
 - Under the Articles, states had the ability to print their own _____, creating a lot of confusion and trade issues
 - Man who proposed finding a middle ground on the issue of how many representatives each state should get (last name only)
 - Name for a middle ground agreement in which there are two houses of Congress, one based on population size and one with an equal number of representatives for all states
 - Name for the first 10 amendments to the Constitution, designed to satisfy those who feared the new federal government could trample the rights of individuals
 - Author of a large majority of the Federalist Papers (last name only)
 - Number of states needed to formally approve the Constitution
 - Branch of government which interprets laws
 - Law which created guidelines for how to divide up the new land controlled by the US after the Revolutionary War
 - 1787 law which created guidelines for how new states would be admitted to the union
 - Supporters of the new Constitution and its strong central government
 - In order to satisfy southern states, Congress was forbidden from interfering with this for 20 years
 - A written plan that provides the basic framework of government
 - Plan in which Congressional representation would be equal for all states
 - Title of the chief executive of the US government
 - Building where the new Constitution was created (____ Hall)
 - The city where the Founding Fathers met to revise the Articles of Confederation
 - "Father of the Constitution" (last name only)
 - Term for people who did not support the Constitution because it created too strong of a central government
 - Time period of rational and informed thinking in Europe which influenced the Founding Fathers ideas on government
 - Oldest member of the Constitutional Convention (last name only)
 - A region of land that is not a state but is designated by Congress and led by a governor
 - To formally approve a plan or agreement
 - This practice was banned by Congress in the northern part of the territory gained from Britain
