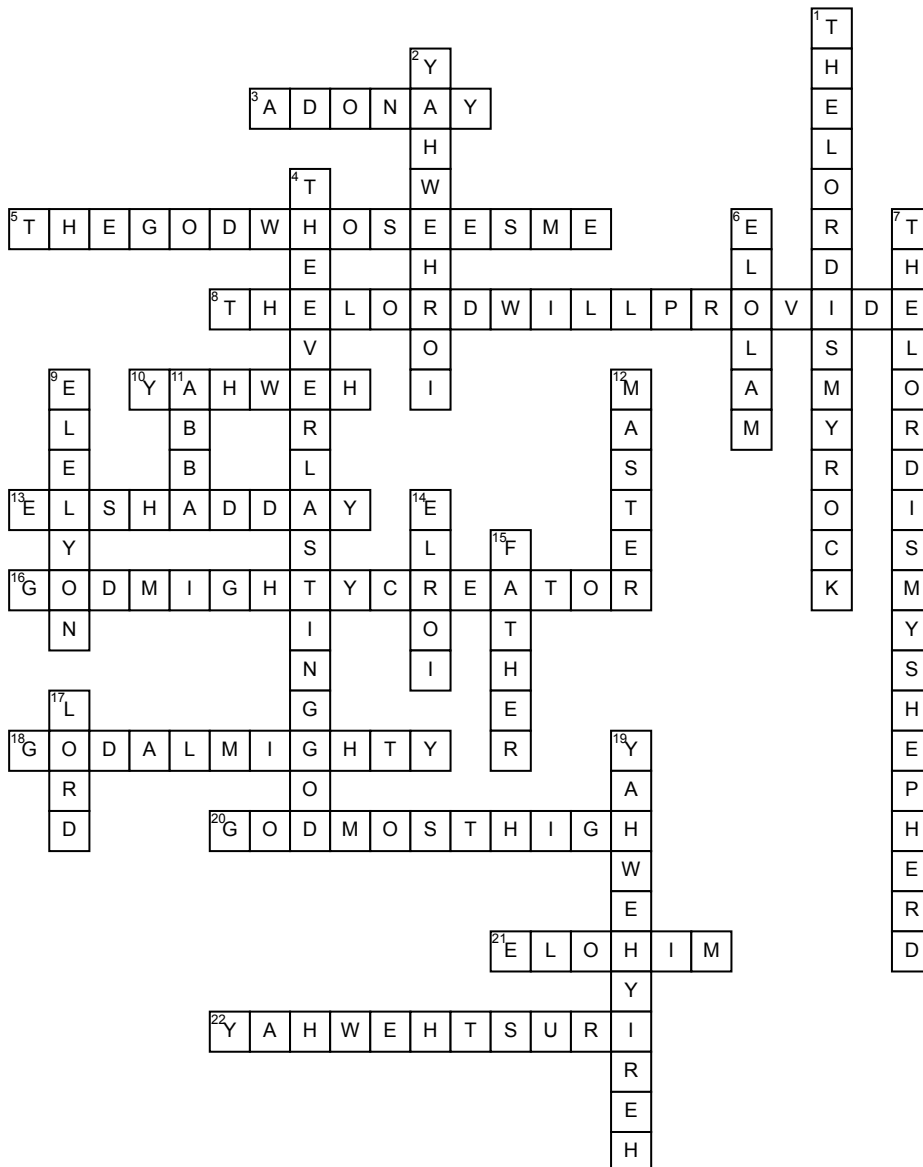


# Names of God
