

4. Appears horizontally and is identified by numbers on the left side of the worksheet window **10.** The cell in the worksheet in which you can type data **12.** All cells touch each other and form a rectangle **13.** The intersection of a row and a column

18. Cell reference area located below the Ribbon; displays the cell reference of the active cell **19.** A page turned so that its longer side is at the top Down

**1.** A computerized spreadsheet 2. Appears to the right of the Name Box and displays a formula when the cell of a worksheet contains a calculated value 3. Includes 2 or more adjacent ranges and selected cells 5. A grid of rows and columns in which you enter text, numbers, and the results of calculations

6. The worksheet that is displayed in the work area 7. A page turned so that its shorter side is at the top 8. Identifies the cell, and is formed by combining the cell's column letter and row number 9. Tab at the bottom of the worksheet window that displays the name of the worksheet **11.** Appears vertically and is identified by letters at the top of the worksheet window **16.** An equation that calculates a new value from values currently in a worksheet
