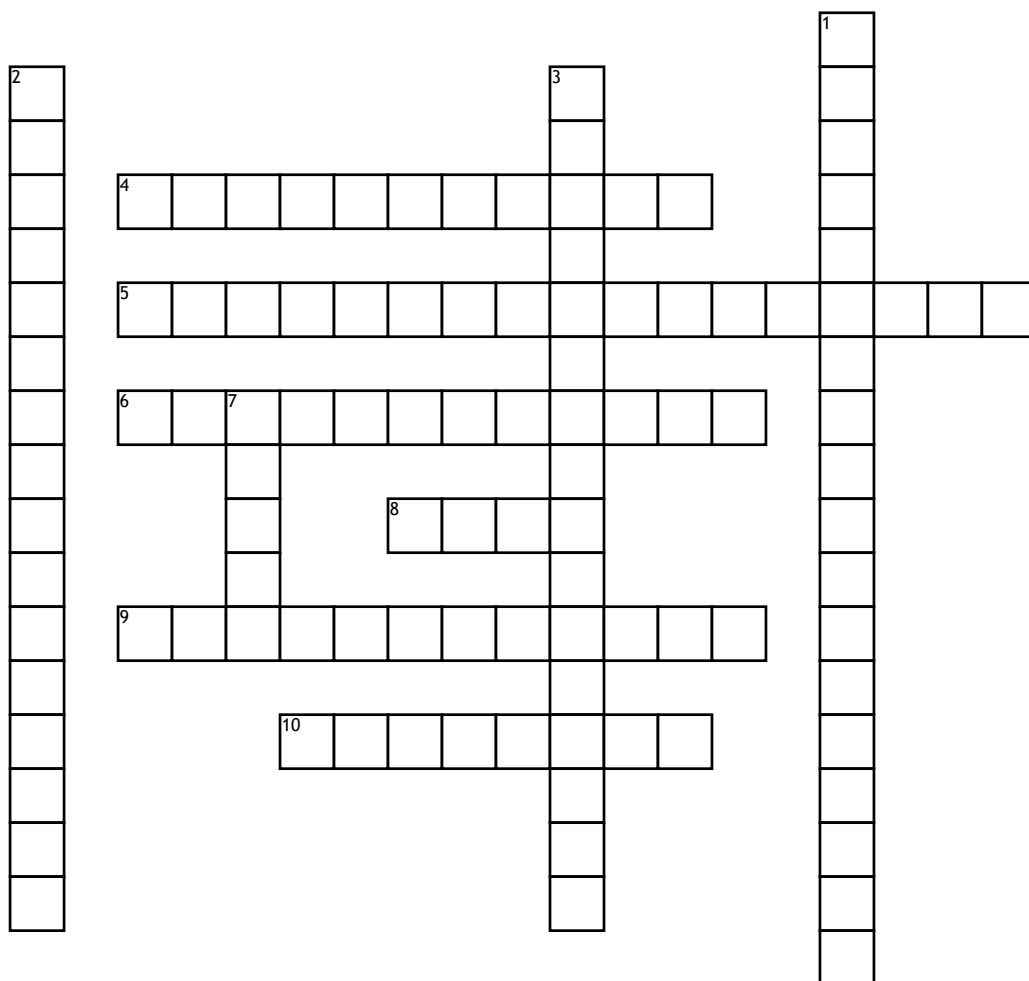


Unit 5 Crossword Puzzle
