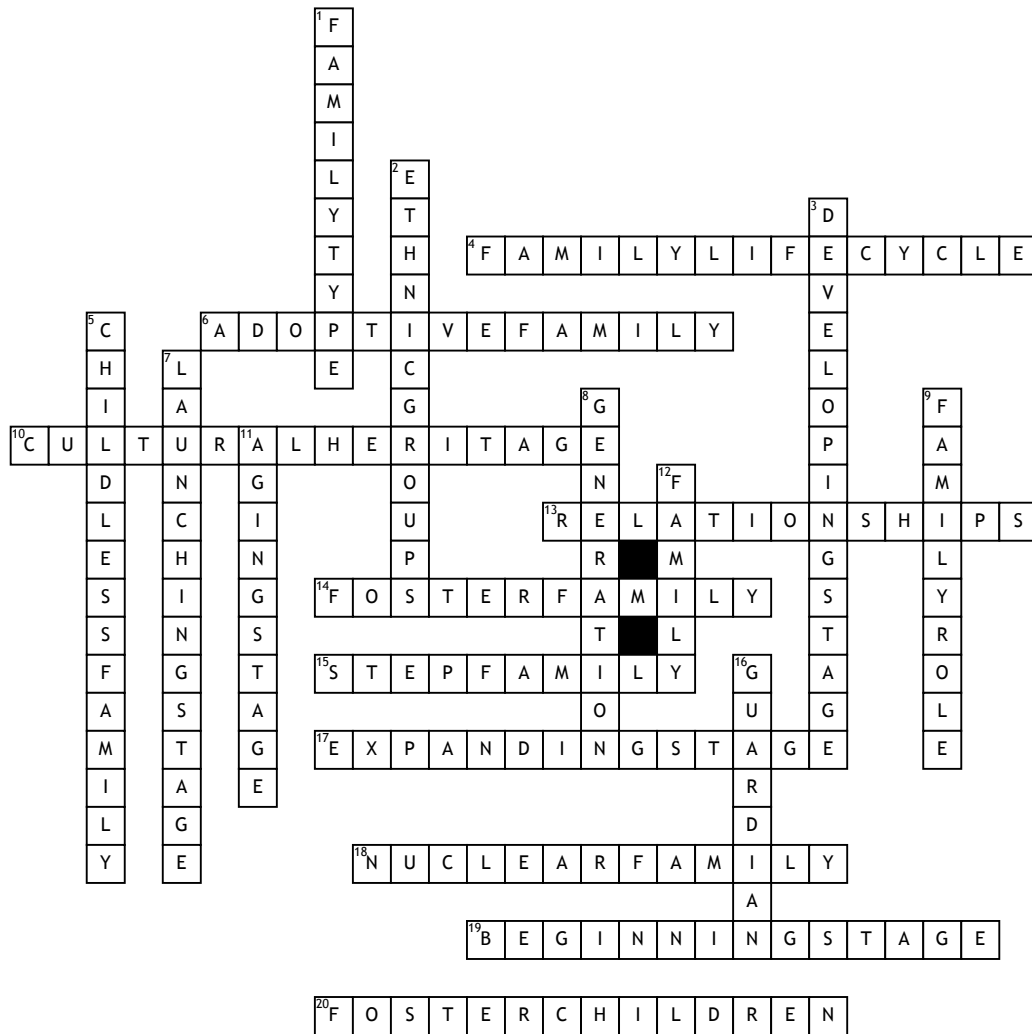


# Understanding Family Relationships
