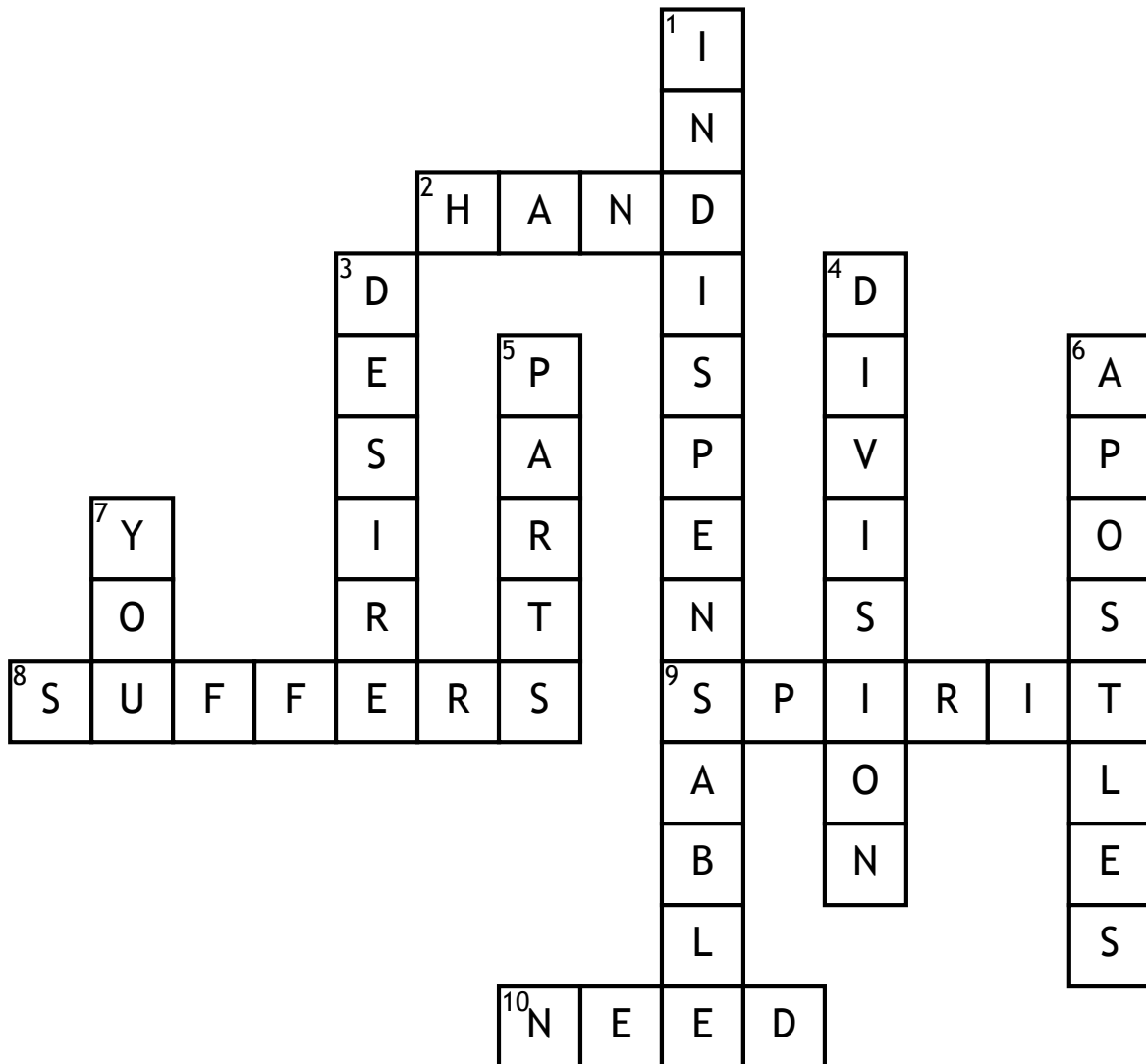


# The Body of Christ (1 Corinthians 12:12-31)
