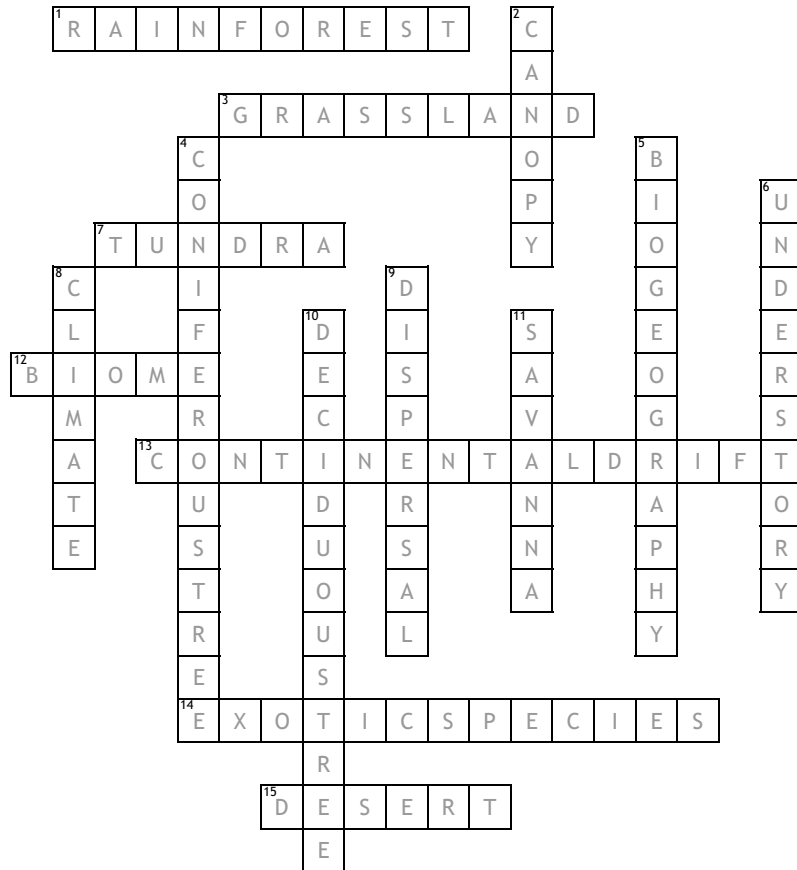

- Humid biomes that receives lots of rain, with a large variety of plant and animal species, there are two different types: tropical and temperate. The two differ in location and temperature
- An area that is populated mostly by grasses and other non-woody plant, and receive 50 to 90 cm of rainfall
- An extremely cold, dry Biome that receives less than 25 cm of rain per year.
- A group of land ecosystems with similar climates and organisms
- The very slow movement of the continents
- An organism that is carried into a new location by people
- An area that receives less than 25 cm of rainfall per year

Down

- A leafy roof formed by tall trees
- A tree that produces its seeds in cones and that has needle-shaped leaves
- The study of where organisms live
- A layer of shorter trees and vines below the canopy
- The typical weather patterns over a long period of time
- The movement of organisms from one place to another; caused by wind, water, or other living things
- Sheds its leaves and grows new ones each year
- A grassland close to the equator that receives as much as 130 cm of rainfall per year
