
Bones Crossword Puzzle

- **10.** the other large bone on the forearm, bigger than the radius
- **11.** this bone is closest bone to the hip joint; also known as thigh bone

- **15.** the bone that connects the humerus with the clavicle; also known as shoulder blade
- 18. digital bones in the hands and feet
- **19.** also known as calf bone, it is the smaller bone that is located lateral of the other

- **1.** one of the two large bones of the forearm, shorter and smaller than the other
- **4.** this represents the skeleton of someone/somethings head
- **5.** form the intermediate part of the skeletal hand located between the phalanges of the fingers and the carpal bones of the wrist

- **8.** a long flat bone shaped like a necktie located in the center of the chest; also known as breastbone
- **12.** stronger of the two bones, this bone is located on in the leg under the knee next to the fibula
- **13.** a triangular bone that protects the surface of the knee joint
- **16.** the enclosing structure formed by the pelvis, providing attachment for the hind limbs or pelvic fins
- **17.** a cluster of seven articulating bones around the foot
