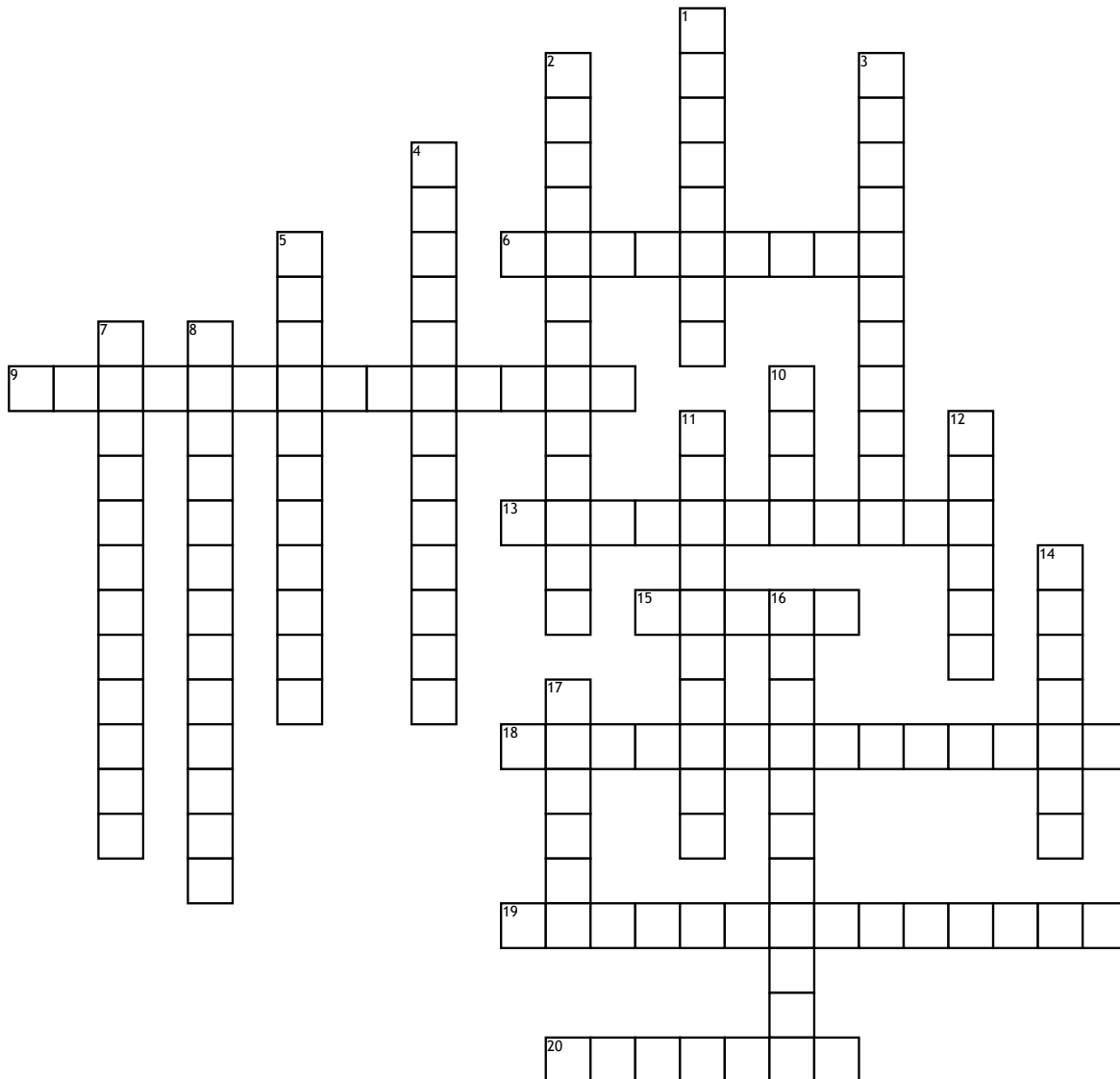


The Book Thief Crossword
