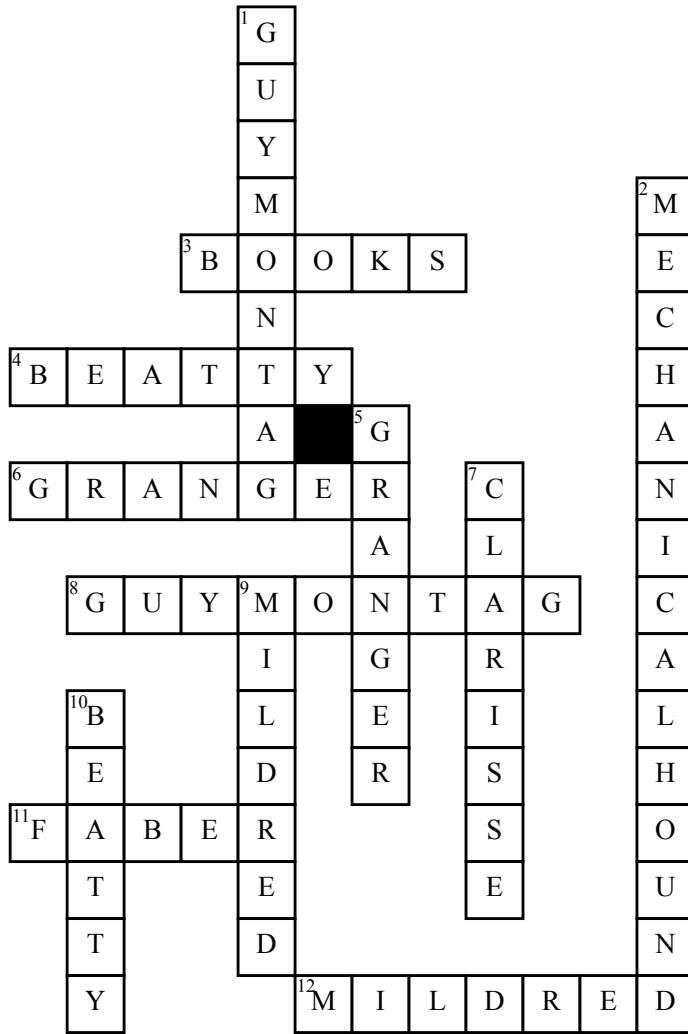


Fahrenheit 451: Characters
