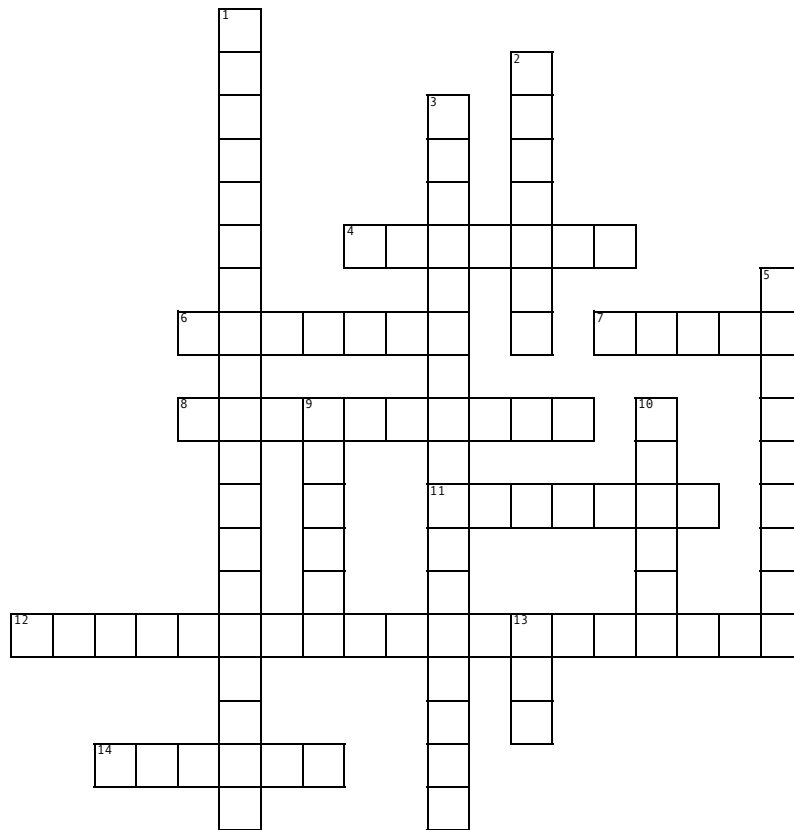

1. Has warm temperatures and high rainfall that allows a lot of plants to grow.
 2. The natural home or environment of an animal, plant, or other organisms.
 3. Gets its name from conifers, the main type of tree that grows there.

 9. A region that has little or no plant life, long periods without rain, and extreme temperatures: usually found in hot climates.
