

- 1. care for residents needing post acut care from both nursing and rehabilitation services
- 2. licensed health professional who uses methods that include exercise, heath, massage, mobilization, and manipulation to reduce pain and improve mobility
- **3.** staff member who assesses residents' functional capabilities and determines the appropriate level of care
- 4. general manager of the facility
- **5.** senior nursing professional who directs the approach for care and determines staffing requirements
