

- **2.** Refers to which parent provides a physical home for the child.
- **9.** The division of custody of a child or children that is between the 2 separated or divorced parents.
- **10.**: Parents (whether they are married or not) are obliged to financially support and provide proper care for their children
- **12.** The legally or formally recognized union of a man and a woman
- **13.** An out of court approved agreement reached between the parties and is then registered with the Family Court registry

- **14.** The care of a person or thing, generally under court orders
- **15.** Set of orders made by a court about parenting arrangements for a child
- **16.** A person who has the legal authority to care for the personal and property interests of another person

- 1. Amicable agreement about how their children will be cared for and supported after separation or divorce
- **3.** The action or state of moving or being moved apart
- **4.** The legal dissolution of a marriage by a court or other competent body

- **5.** When a court has decided that a divorce should be granted
- **6.** Statutes, court decisions, and provisions of the federal and state constitutions that relate to family relationships, rights, duties, and finances.
- 7. In a Divorce or custody action, permission granted by the court to a noncustodial parent to visit his or her child or children.
- **8.** A parent who has sole legal custody
- **11.** Is a court order whereby custody of a child is awarded to both parties.
