 9. The division of custody of a

child or children that is between the 2 separated or divorced parents.

10. : Parents (whether they are married or not) are obliged to financially support and provide proper care for their children
12. The legally or formally recognized union of a man and a woman

13. An out of court approved agreement reached between the parties and is then registered with the Family Court registry 14. The care of a person or thing, generally under court orders15. Set of orders made by a court about parenting arrangements for a child

16. A person who has the legal authority to care for the personal and property interests of another person **Down**

1. Amicable agreement about how their children will be cared for and supported after separation or divorce

3. The action or state of moving or being moved apart
