

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<u>Across</u>

2. Yarns that run in the crosswise direction, like the weft yarn in woven fabric

5. The direction of the lengthwise and crosswise yarns in a woven fabric

6. The process of interacting one or more sets of yarns at right angles on a loom

7. Yarns that run in the length direction, like a wrap yarns in woven fabric

12. A very weak weave that produces a smooth, shinny-surface fabric

13. Used for t-shirts, sweaters, and tights

15. The yarn that runs length wise in woven fabric

- 16. The diagonal grain of the fabric
- 17. Nonwoven fabrics

18. Two yarns and two needles are used

19. Stable knits that lie flat and don't run on ravel

20. Yarn that runs crosswise in woven fabric

<u>Down</u>

1. A very strong weave in which the weft yarn is passed over and under one, two or three wrap yarns

3. The process of pulling loops of yarns through other loops to create interlocking rows of stitches.

4. An extra yarn is used to create a patterned design in these kints, used for lacy knits, thermal underwear

8. Is the rise surface or nap of a fabric, which is made of upright loops or strands of yarn

9. The simplest weave in which the weft yarn is passed over them under each wrap yarn

10. Have vertical "ribs" used for neck, wrist, and bottom bands of sweaters and jackets

11. A knit made with only one yarn14. A knit made with several yarns on flat knitting machines
