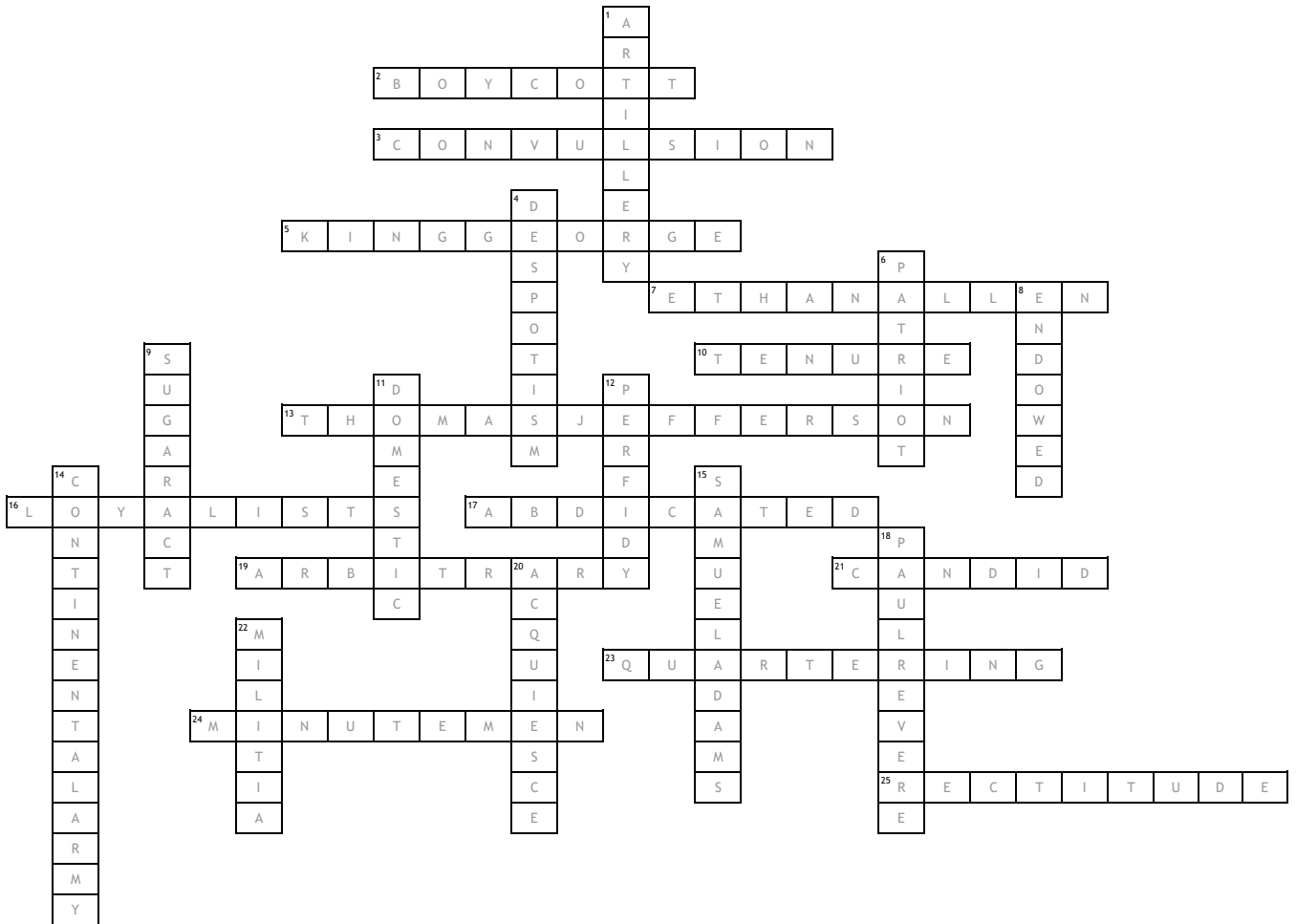


ROAD TO REVOLUTION
