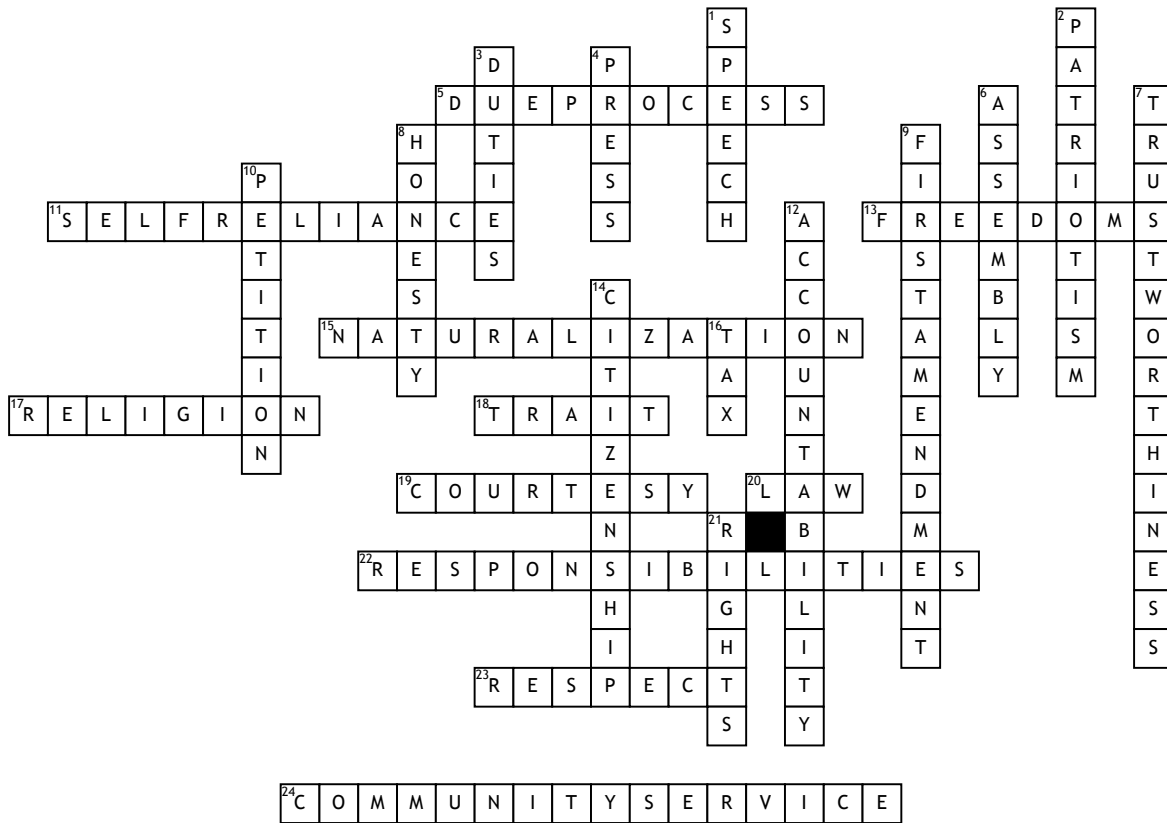


# Citizenship
