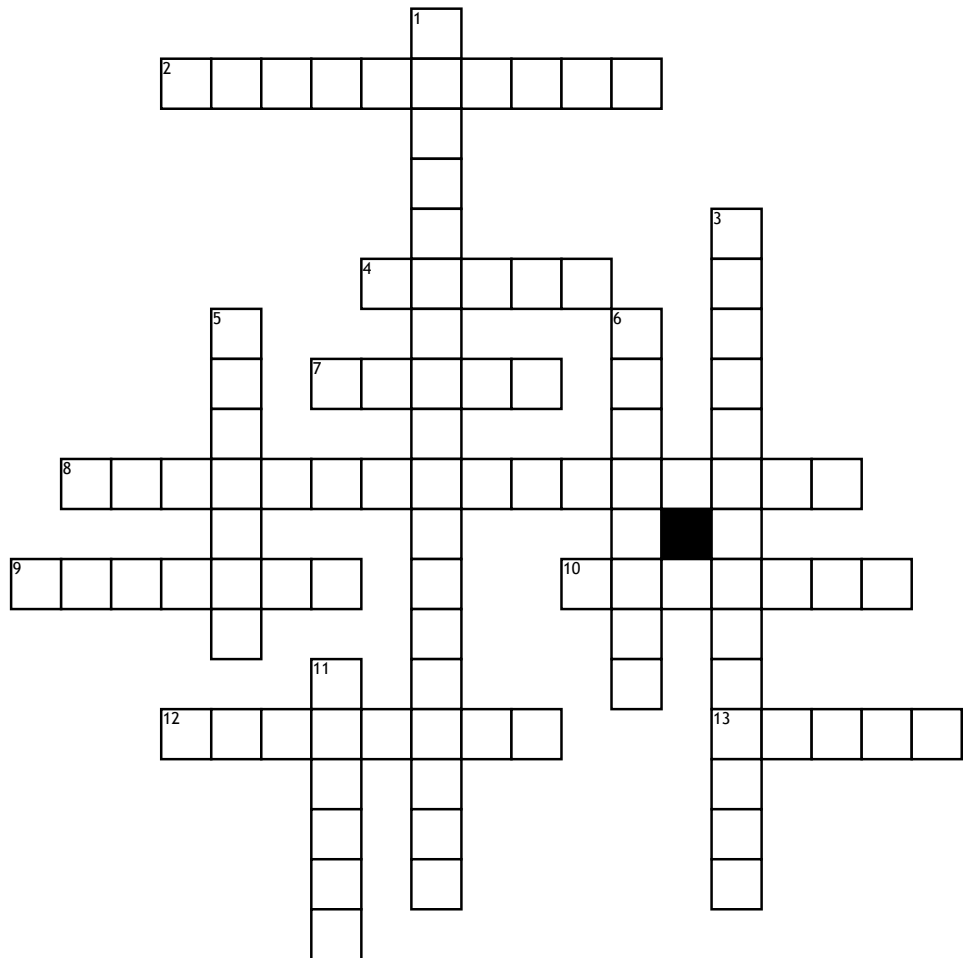
2. This refers to the size and shape of furnishings in relation to the overall shape and size of a room.
