2. small group of powerful people make most government decisions; membership based on wealth (aristocracy), family or military power
3. people elect representatives to make decisions on their behalf
4. supreme power to act within its territory and to control its external affairs
5. ultimate authority rests in a single national government
6. government is headed by one person, such as a king or queen who exercises spreme authority
7. the formal institutions and processes through which decisions are made for a group of people
8. political unit with the power to make and enforce laws over a group of people living within a clearly defined territory
9. one person or small group holds unlimited power over government
