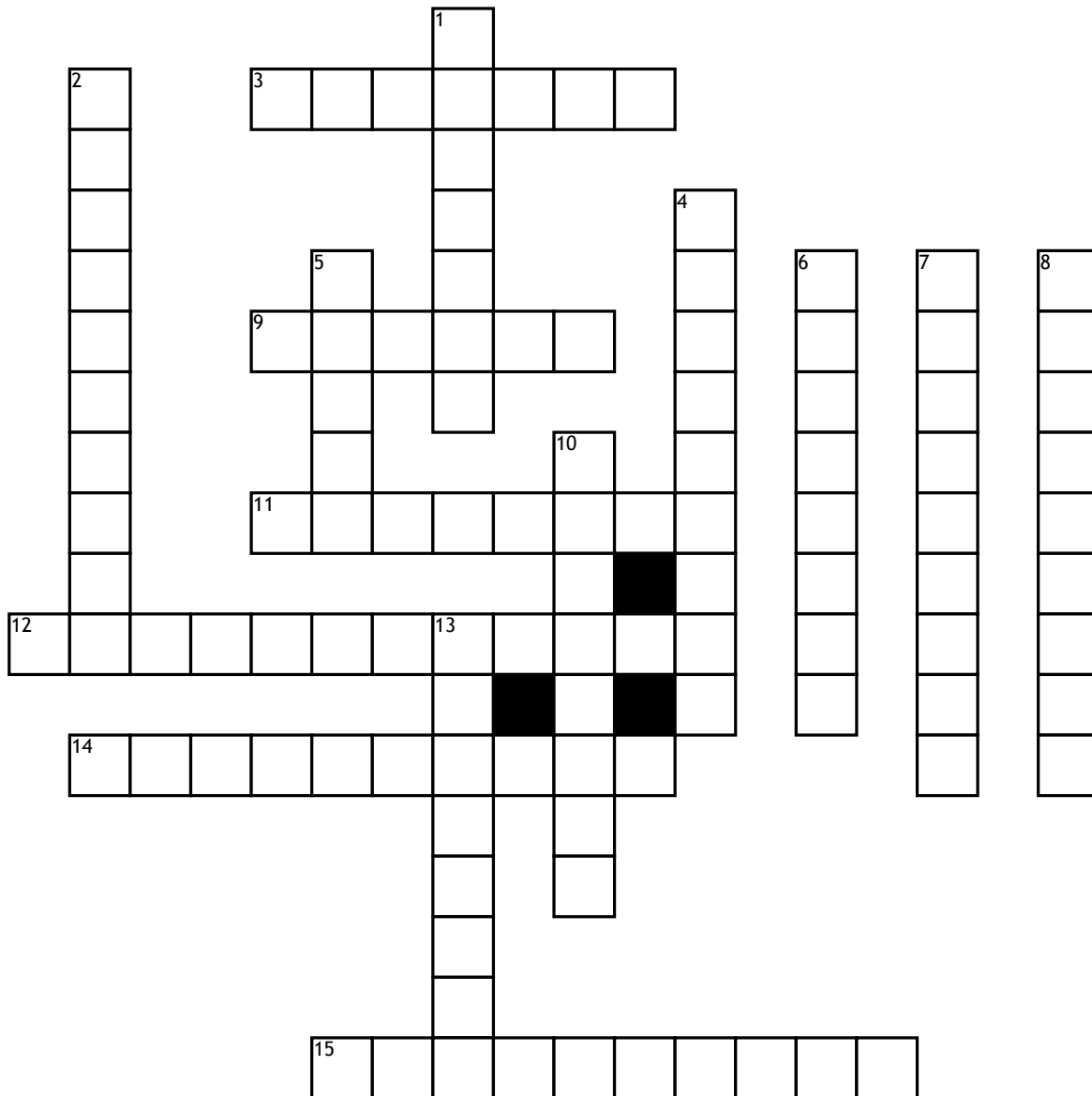


River Landscapes and Processes

3. Water wears away rocks and soil on the river banks and bed.
 9. Where a river starts, usually a lake or spring
 11. Bends usually in the middle course of a river.
 12. The gentle slope on the inside of a meander bend.
 14. Flat land next to a river which is sometimes flooded.

1. the mouth of a river which broadens into the sea and is affected by tides.
 2. A hollow under a waterfall created by erosion and filled with water.
 4. The boundary separating two drainage basins.
 5. A steep, narrow valley with rocky sides.

6. Fine sediments which are deposited by a river.

7. A stream or small river that joins a larger one.

8. A type of erosion where rocks in a river hit each other, slowly becoming smaller.

10. The speed at which a river flows.

13. The process where some minerals dissolve in a river.
