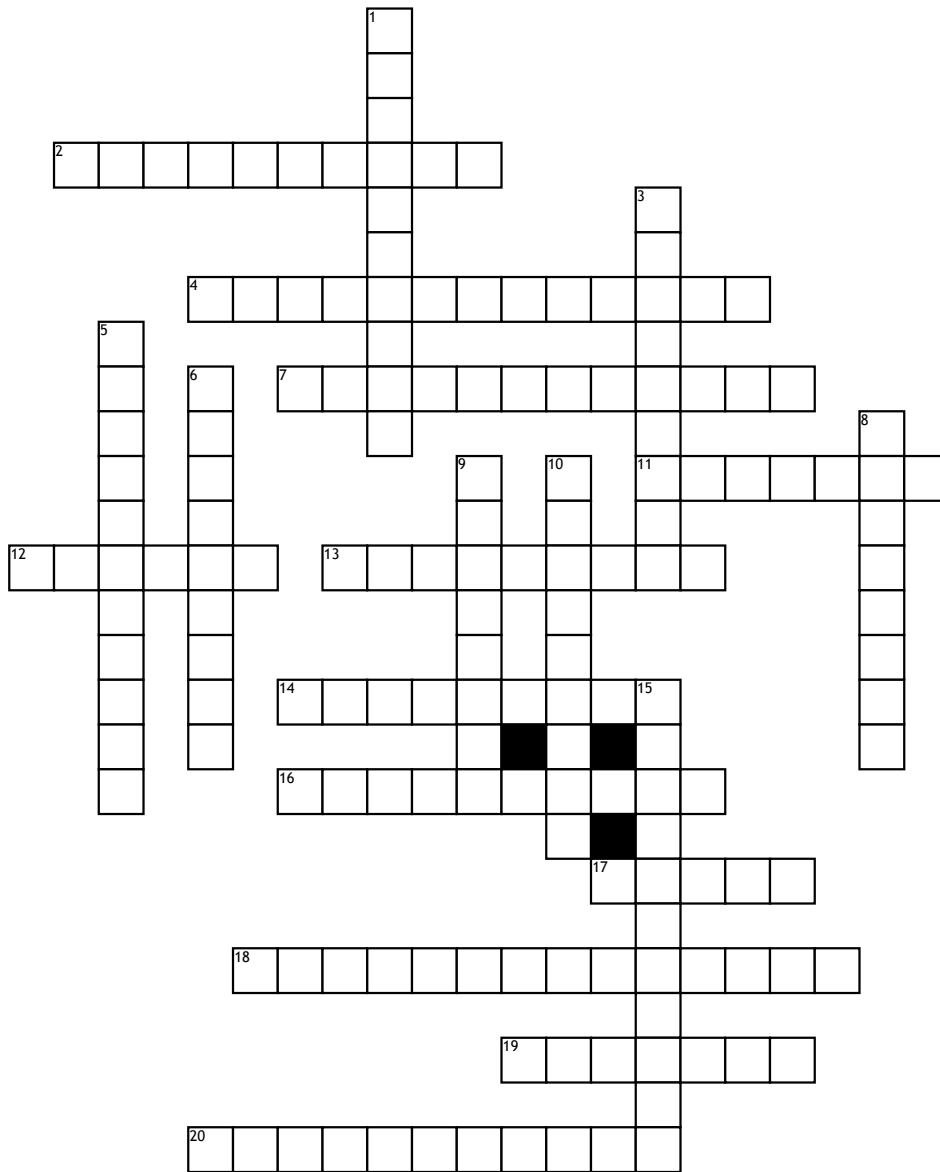


Cardiovascular Drugs

- 2. used as an antiarrhythmic
- 4. treats angina
- 7. adverse effects include rhabdomyolysis
- 11. reduces intraocular pressure
- 12. water soluble vitamin
- 13. increases cardiac contraction; short term treatment of heart failure
- 14. common side effect of memantine hydrochloride
- 16. slows progression of heart failure

- 17. common side effect of ACE inhibitors

- 18. take 1 hour before or 4-6 hours after thiazide diuretics
- 19. antidote that binds to the drug to correct toxicity
- 20. treats severe hypertension

- 1. part of the core measures for MI
- 3. used for HTN in those who can not tolerate ACE inhibitors
- 5. off label use for stage fright

- 6. interacts with grapefruit juice to create toxic drug levels
- 8. observe for extravasation
- 9. decreases secretions and used to increase heart rate in bradycardia
- 10. if given with NSAIDs increases risk of GI bleed
- 15. decreases vomiting in motion sickness
