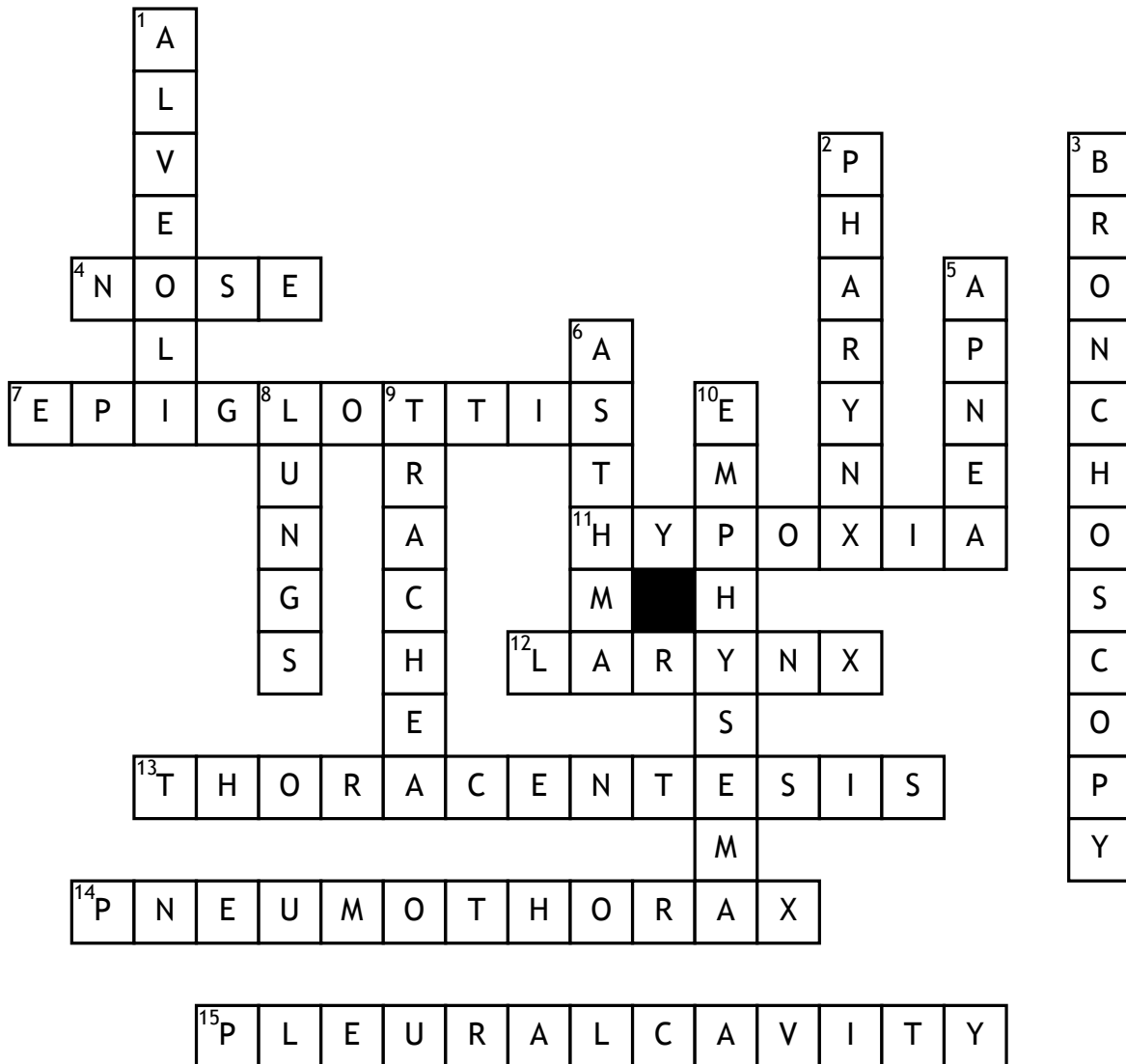


Pulmonary System



Across

4. Serves as an air passageway, warms and moistens inhaled air

7. Acts as a lid to prevent aspiration of food into the trachea

11. Condition of deficient amounts of oxygen in body tissue

12. Produces vocal sounds, also called voice box

13. Surgical puncture of chest for removal of fluid

14. Condition where there is collection of air between chest wall and lung, causing lung collapse

15. Space between the parietal and visceral pleura containing fluid that lubricates and prevents friction

Down

1. Tiny air sacs supporting a network of capillaries from pulmonary blood vessels

2. Serves as a passageway for food and air

3. Visual examination of the larynx, trachea, and bronchi with scope

5. Cessation of breathing

6. Disease of the bronchi characterized by wheezing and dyspnea

8. Bring air into contact with blood so oxygen and carbon dioxide can be exchanged in the alveoli

9. Provides an open passageway for air to and from the lungs

10. Chronic pulmonary disease where alveoli are distended and damaged
