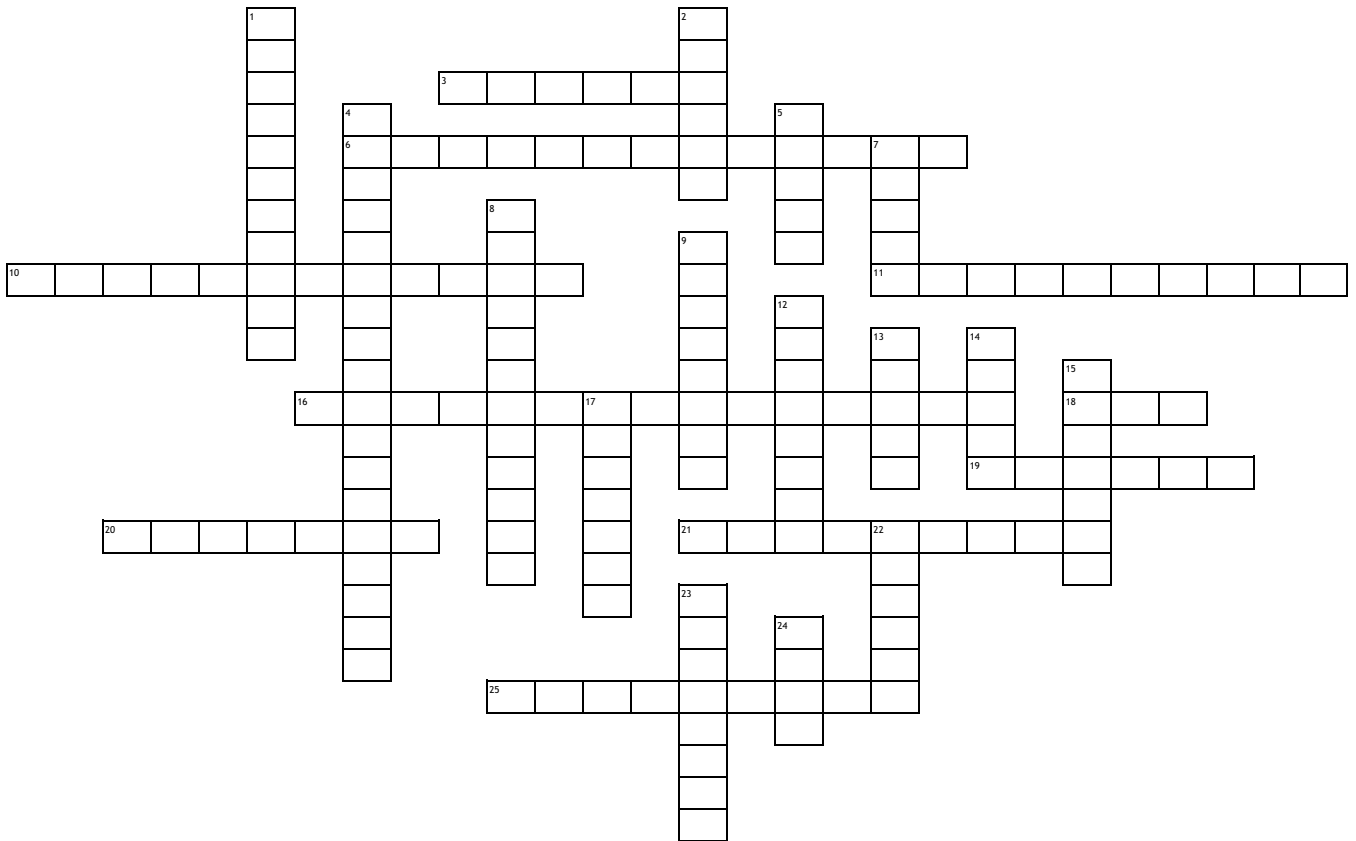


# Figurative Language Crossword Puzzle
