2. fibers from natural sources, mainly plants and animals
3. fabric tube that holds elastic or a drawstring
4. using heat and an up and down motion to set seams, pleats, etc
8. "teeth" under the needle plate that help move the fabric beneath the presser foot
11. while stitching a seam the needle is left in the fabric, the presser foot is lifted then the fabric is turned
13. threads of a woven fabric running at a slant
16. changing a garment such as shortening the length of the slacks
18. fibers made in factories from chemicals and other raw materials; referred to as man-made fabrics
