
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## Sewing Machine Terms



## Across

- **2.** Raises and lowers the pressure foot onto the feed.
- **3.** Area that surrounds the feed. Has guideline markings that help keep stitching straight.
- **8.** Moves the fabric forward with each stitch.
- **12.** Holds fabric in place against the feed.
- **14.** Controls the length of the stitch.
- **15.** Holds the thread spool in place as you sew.

- **16.** Controls the tension on the thread as you wind the bobbin.
- 17. Changes the stitch pattern.
- **18.** Feeds thread from spool to needle; moves up and down as the needle moves; 'bob'

## Down

- 1. Used to wind thread onto the bobbin.
- **4.** Control that allows the machine to stitch backwards.
- **5.** Regulates the tightness and looseness of thread.
- **6.** Covers the bobbin to hold it in place as you sew.

- 7. The small, black screw located at the top of the needle that holds it in place.
- **9.** Determines how much pressure the pressure foot will have on the fabric.
- **10.** A small, removable disc that is used to hold a spool of thread in place.
- 11. Disengages the needle while winding the bobbin. Located inside the hand wheel.
- **13.** Moves the take-up lever and needle up and down.
