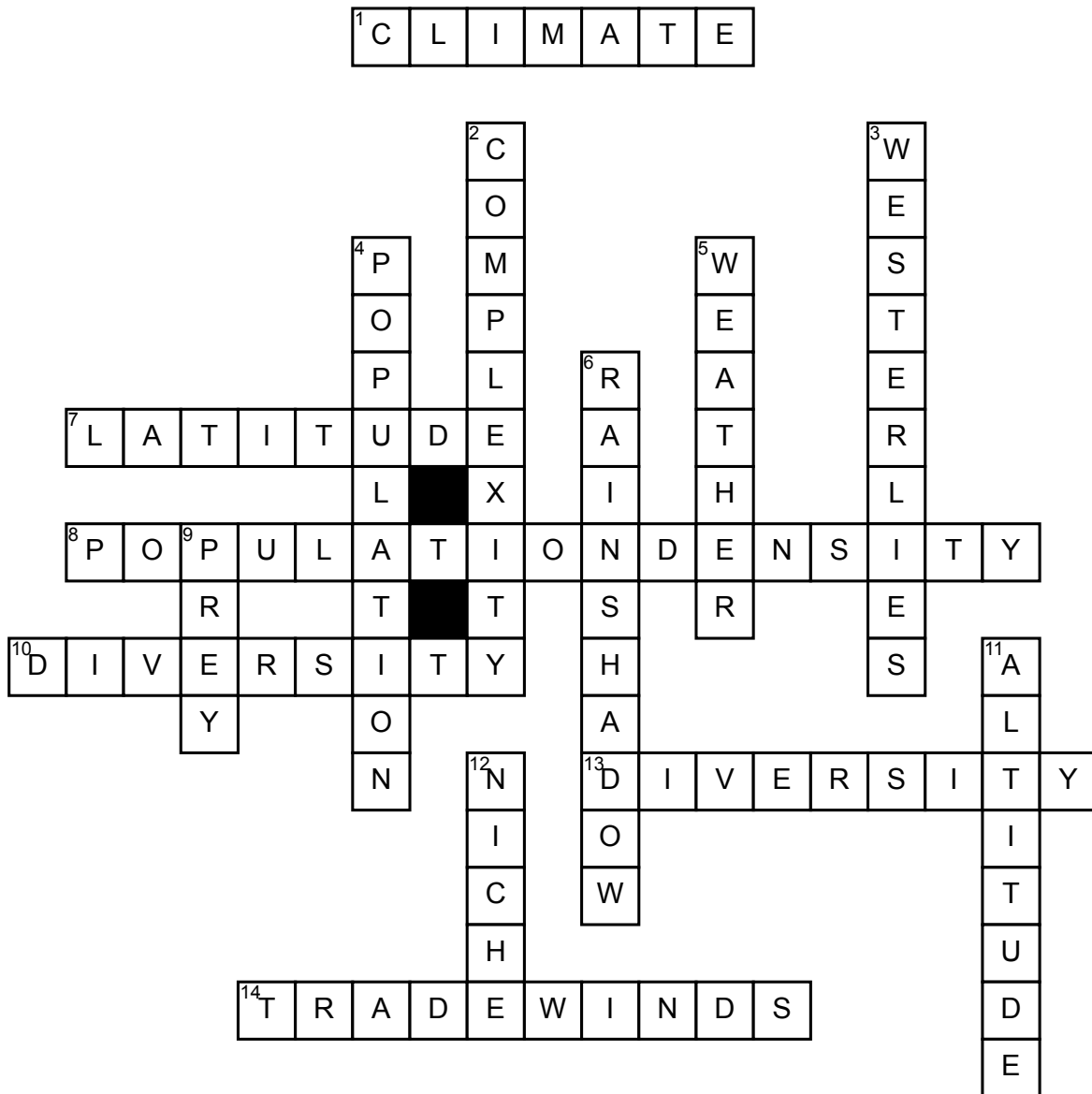


Population Growth
