
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The Nervous System

- 2. branches out of the cells body and receives information from other neurons and pass the message through the cell body
- **5.** transmits messages away from the cell body
- **6.** a column of nerves about as thick as a thumb that extends from the brain down the back
- **9.** brain and spinal corn
- **10.** a white fatty substance that insulates and protects the axon

- 11. a junction between the axon terminals of one neuron and the dendrites of another
- **12.** transmits sensory messages to the central nervous system
- **13.** regulates the body's vital function, such as heartbeat, breathing, digestion, and blood pressure
