

## **Across**

- 3. located in the dermis; carries blood throughout the body; includes veins, arteries, and capillaries
- **4.** contains apocrine and merocrine glands; watery secretion; helps maintain body temperature
- 7. maintains body temperature by contracting muscles when cold
- **8.** protects and insulates; guards opening against particle and insects; is sensitive to very light touch
- **9.** supports the epidermis; contains the papillary and reticular layers
- **10.** layer of dead cells; protects from viruses, bacteria, and other antigens; prevents excessive water loss
