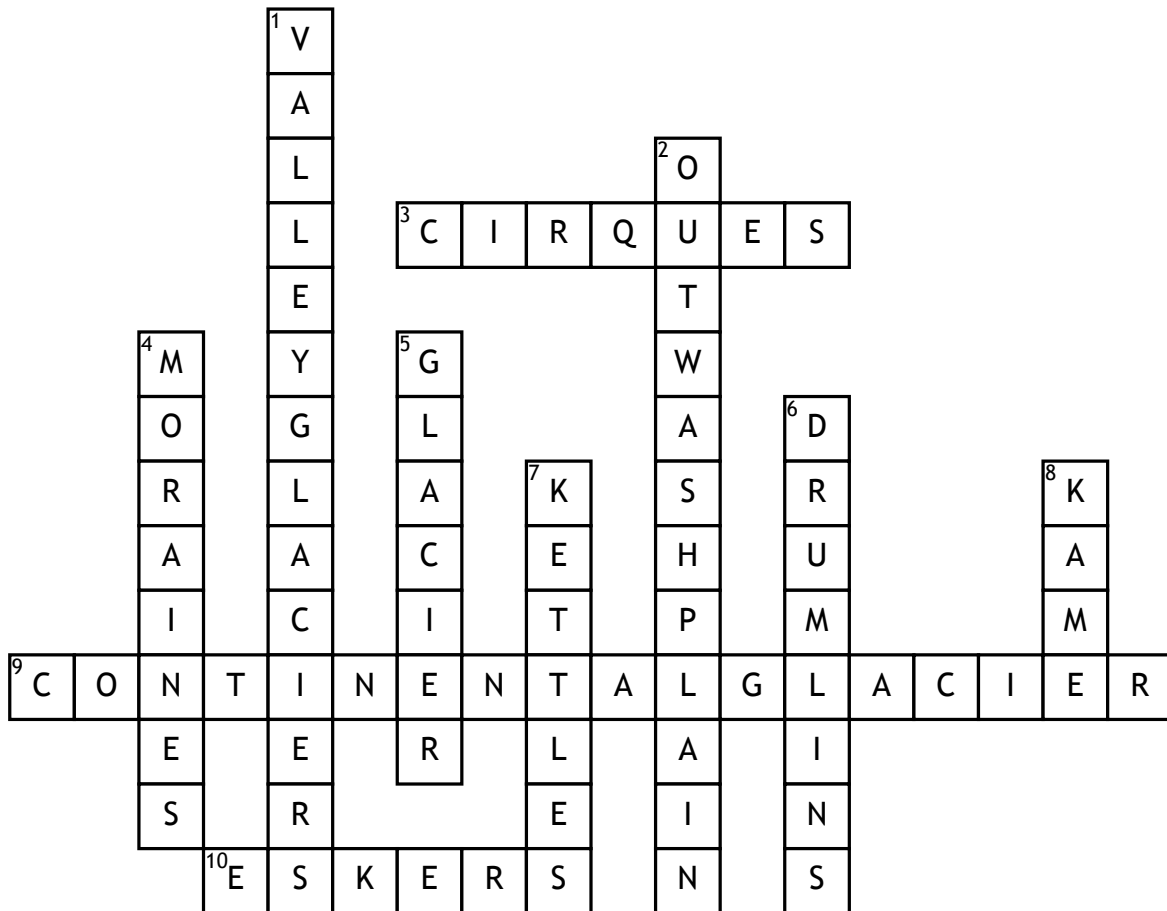

1. Glacier that form in valley in high, mountainous areas

2. The area at the leading edge of the glacier where the meltwater flows and deposits outwash

4. glaciers deposit unsorted ridges of till

5. A large moving mass of ice

6. Continental glaciers that move over older moraines form the material into elongated landforms

7. a steep-sided depression formed by a glacier

8. A mound of layered sediment deposited at the retreating glacier face and is conical in shape
