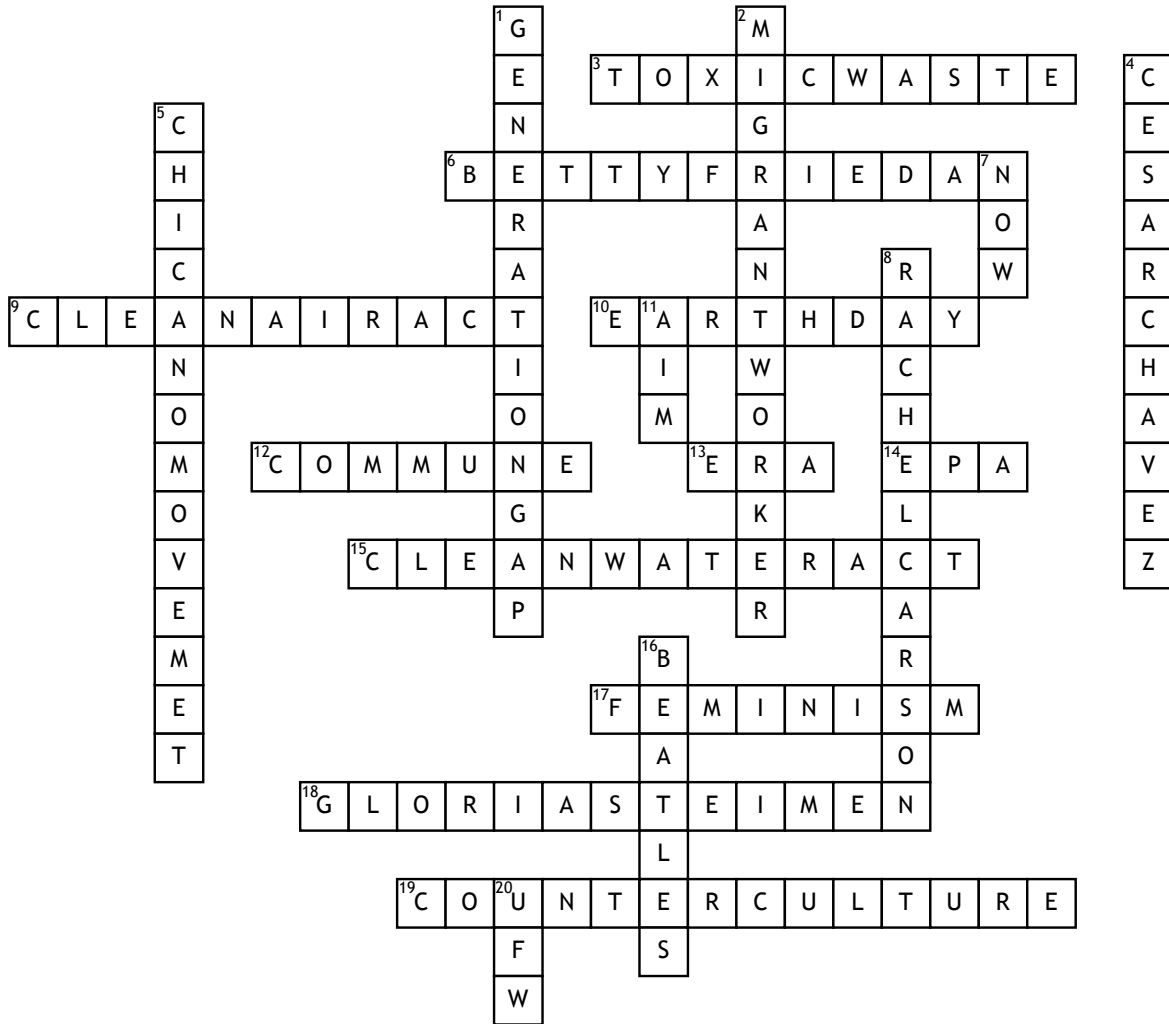


Era of Protest and Change
