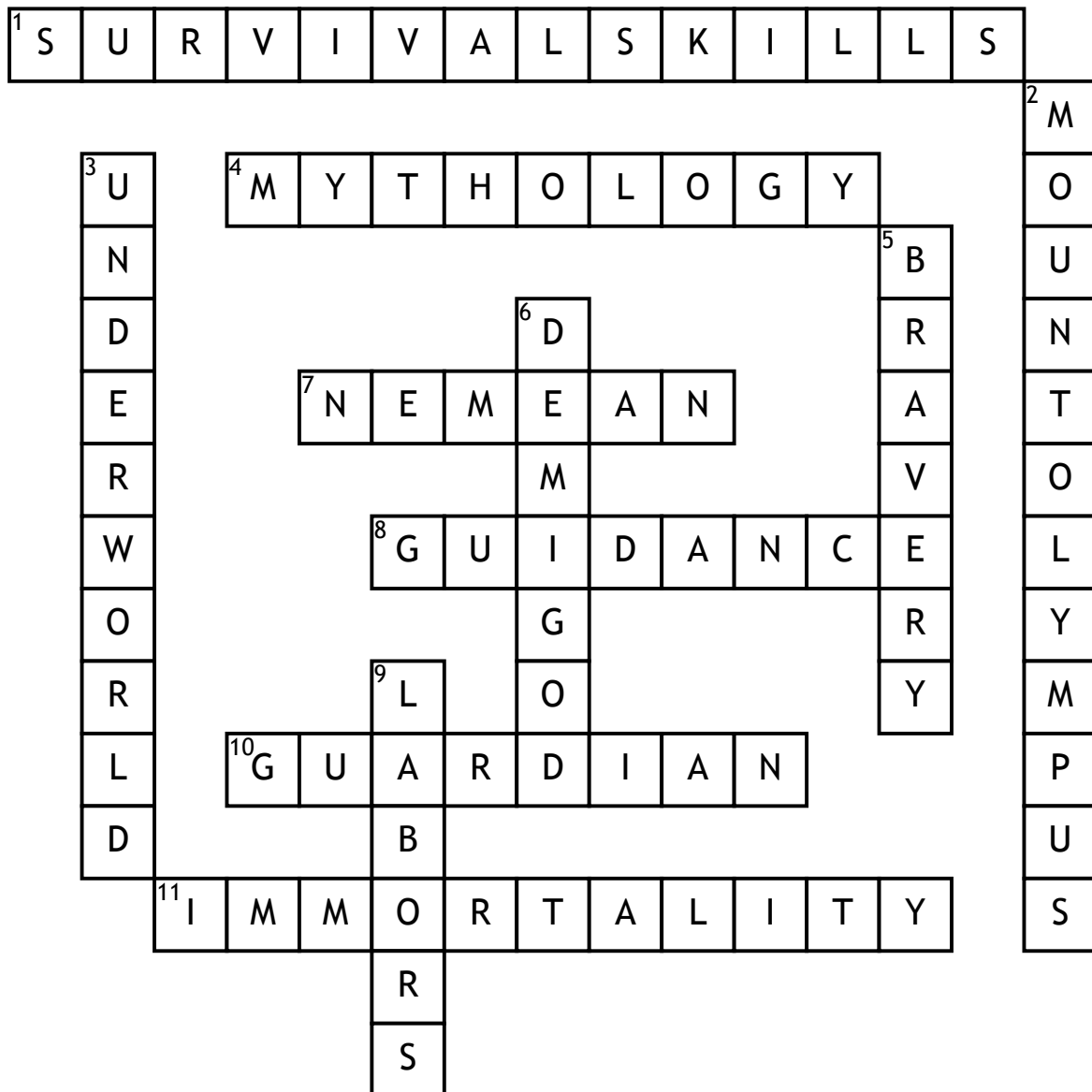


Greek Mythology Twelve Labors of Hercules
