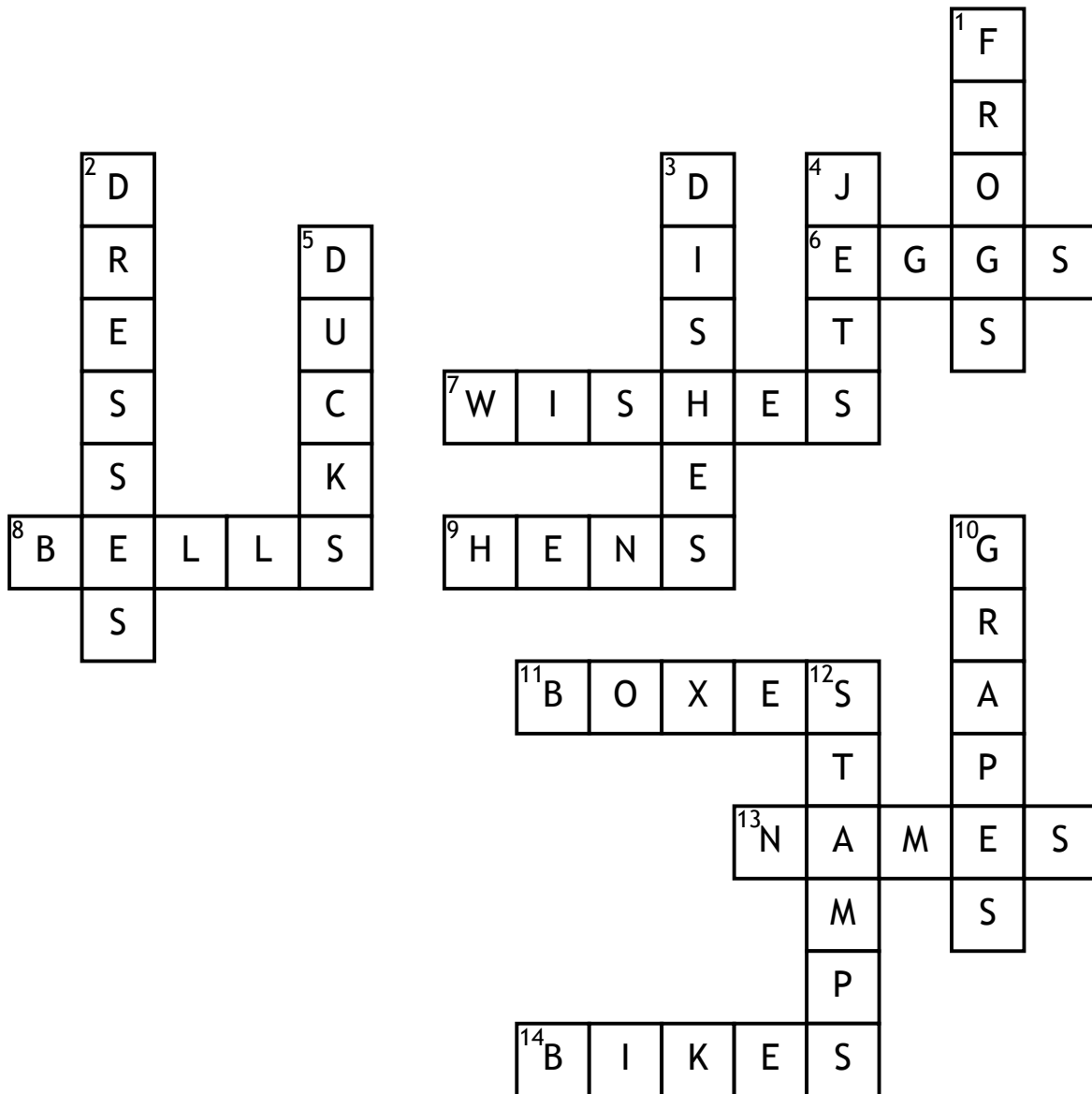


philip's puzzle
