
Unit 8: Education and Training



<u>Across</u>

8. a course that is not required but can be chosen by students according to their interests

1. learning on the job

2. a certificate of completion awarded to a person after completing a program of study in a particular area, usually lasting two years

3. a program of study beyond a bachelor's degree

4. a certificate of completion awarded to a person after successfully completing a required set of college courses in both general and specific areas

5. a program in which a person learns to do a certain job by working with a skilled worker

6. unit of measurement that schools use to determine whether students are progressing toward graduation

7. methods of paying for education/training, such as grants, scholarships, etc.

10. a temporary paid or unpaid position that involves direct work experience in a career field
