- C. First Quarter Moon
- 4. Two weeks have passed since the new moon. We see the entire face of the moon shining. A
- D. Waning Gibbous Moon

6. The moon is a quarter of its way around Earth J

- F. Waxing Gibbous Moon
- 7. A bit of the sunlit side of the moon shows with the light side being on the left B
- G. New Moon

8. The moon is between full moon and last quarter. A

- H. Full Moon
- 9. The moon is increasing in light between a first quarter moon and a full moon E
- I. Waxing Crescent Moon
- 10. The moon is decreasing in light between a full moon and a last quarter moon. D
- J. Waning Crescent Moon
