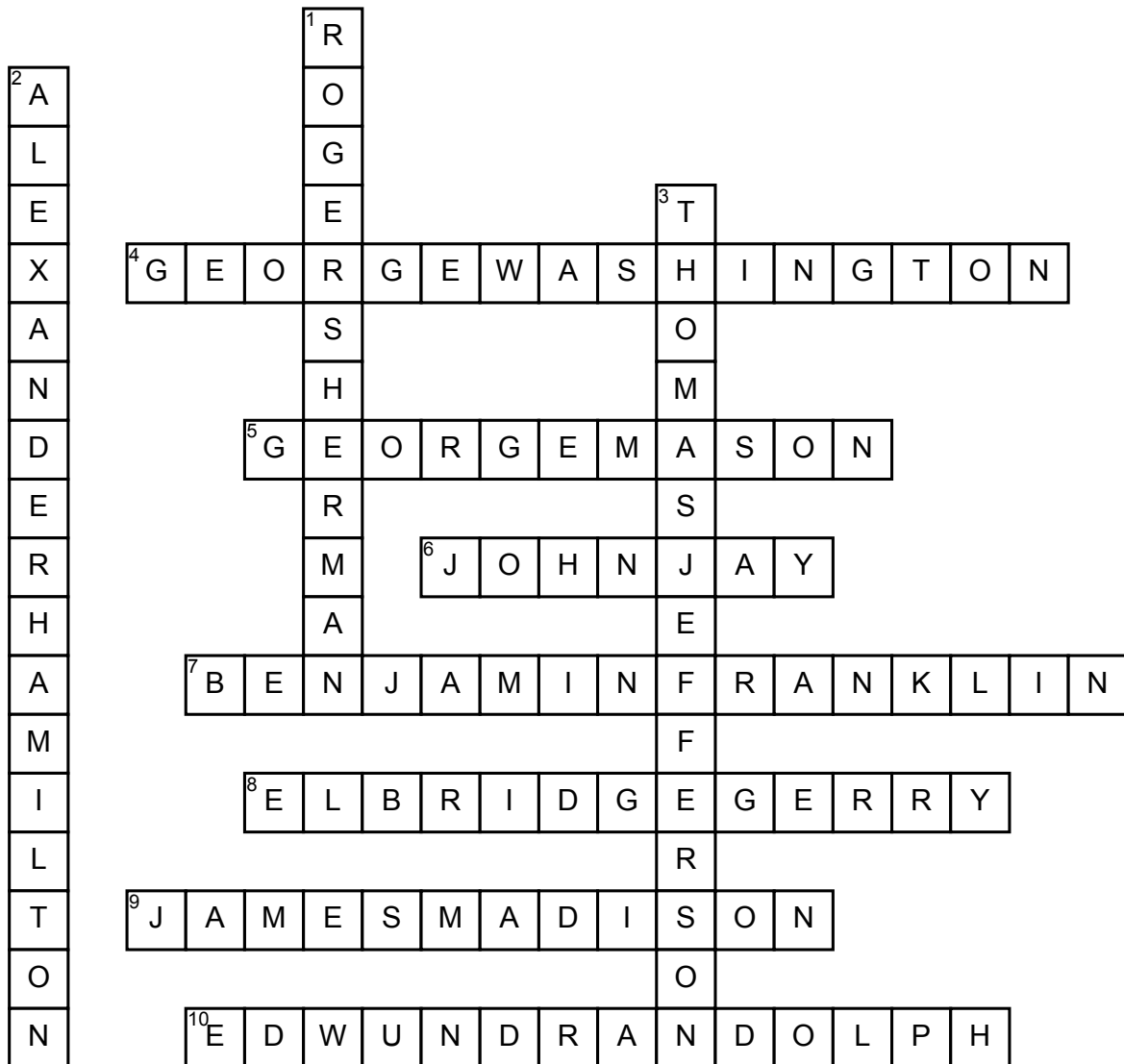


Chapter 8 section 2 and 3 crossword puzzle
