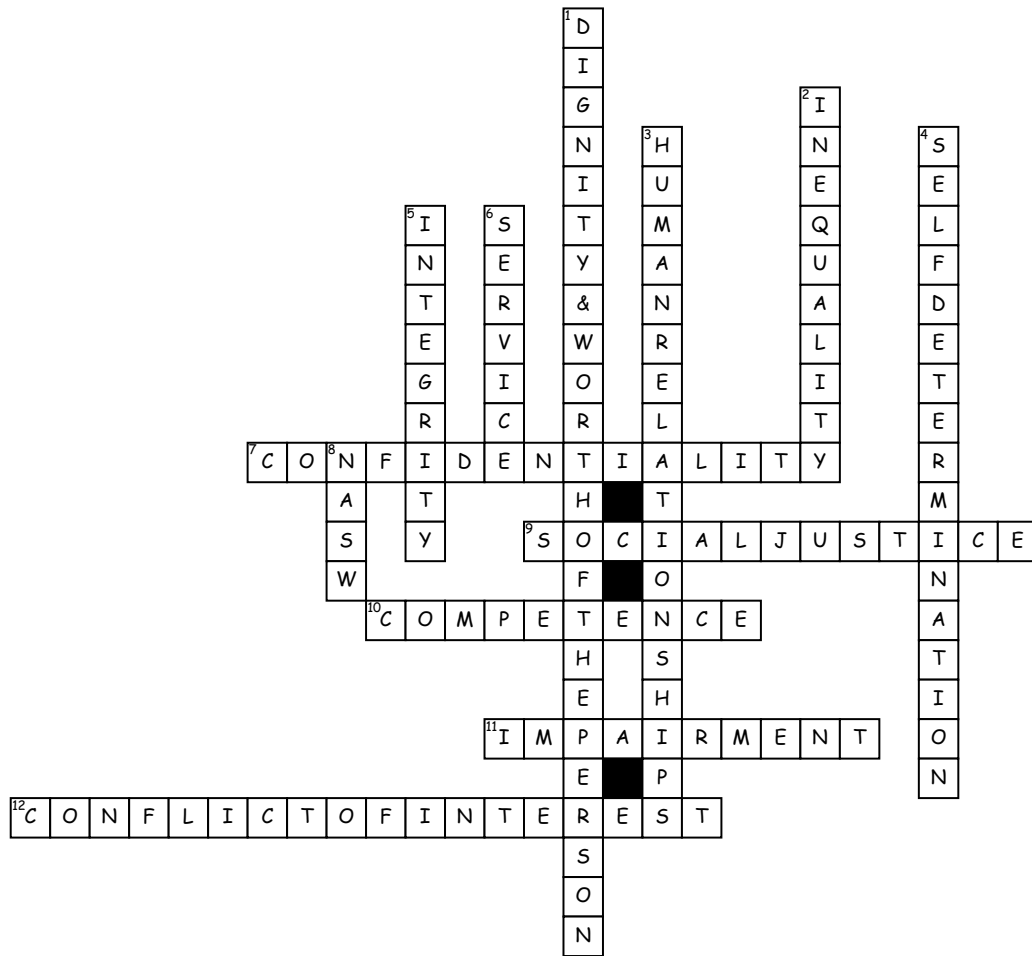


# Core Values & Code of Ethics



## Across

7. Social workers should respect clients' right to privacy. Social workers should not solicit private information from or about clients except for compelling professional reasons.

9. advocate on behalf of the oppressed, the voiceless, and others who are unable to advocate for themselves

10. Scope of practice which includes skill, knowledge, and a positive attitude that empowers

11. Social workers should not allow their own personal problems, psychosocial distress, legal problems, substance abuse, or mental health difficulties to interfere with their professional judgment and performance

12. Social workers should not take unfair advantage of any professional relationship or exploit others to further their personal, religious, political, or business interests.

2. honest, doing the right thing when no one is looking, professional standards, reporting things you suspect

3. connect people who need assistance with organizations and individuals who can provide the appropriate help

5. the quality of being honest and having strong moral principles; moral uprightness.
