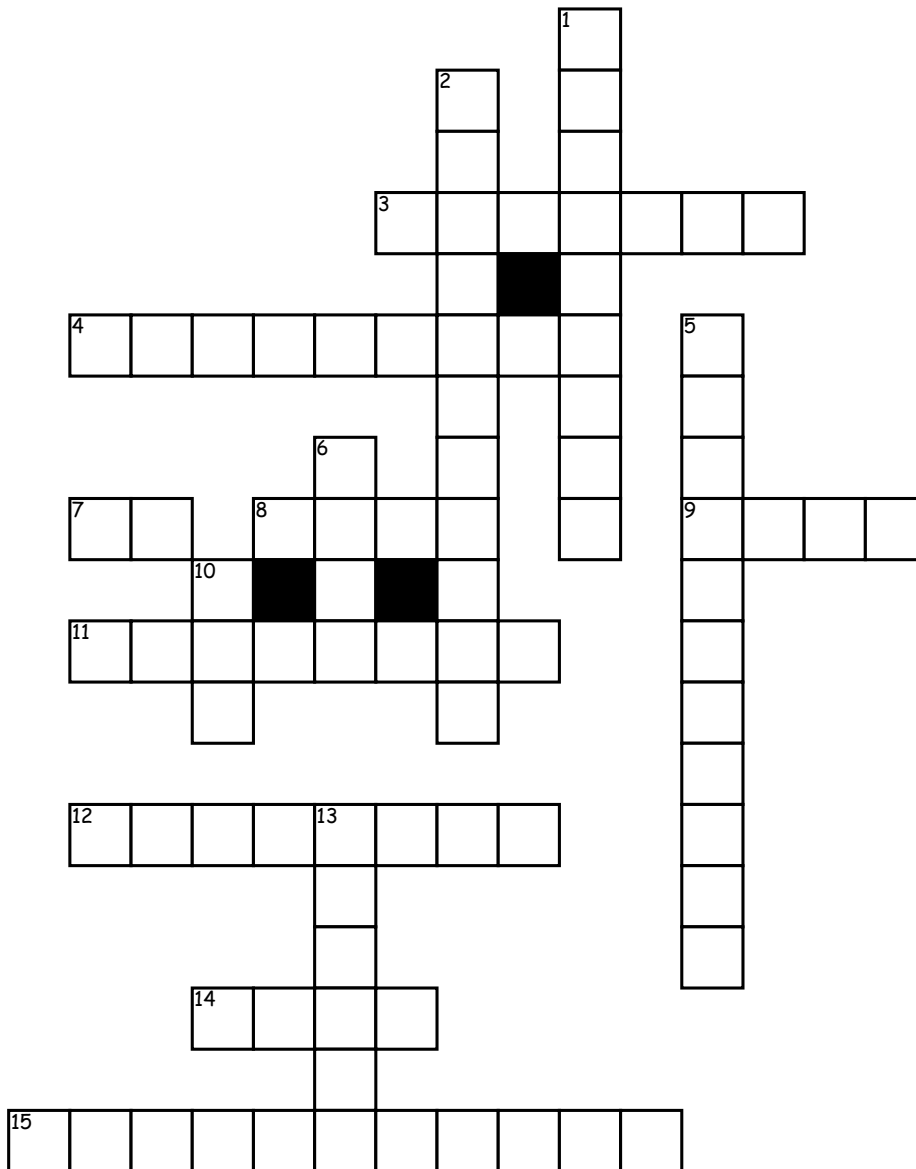


# Ice Skating
