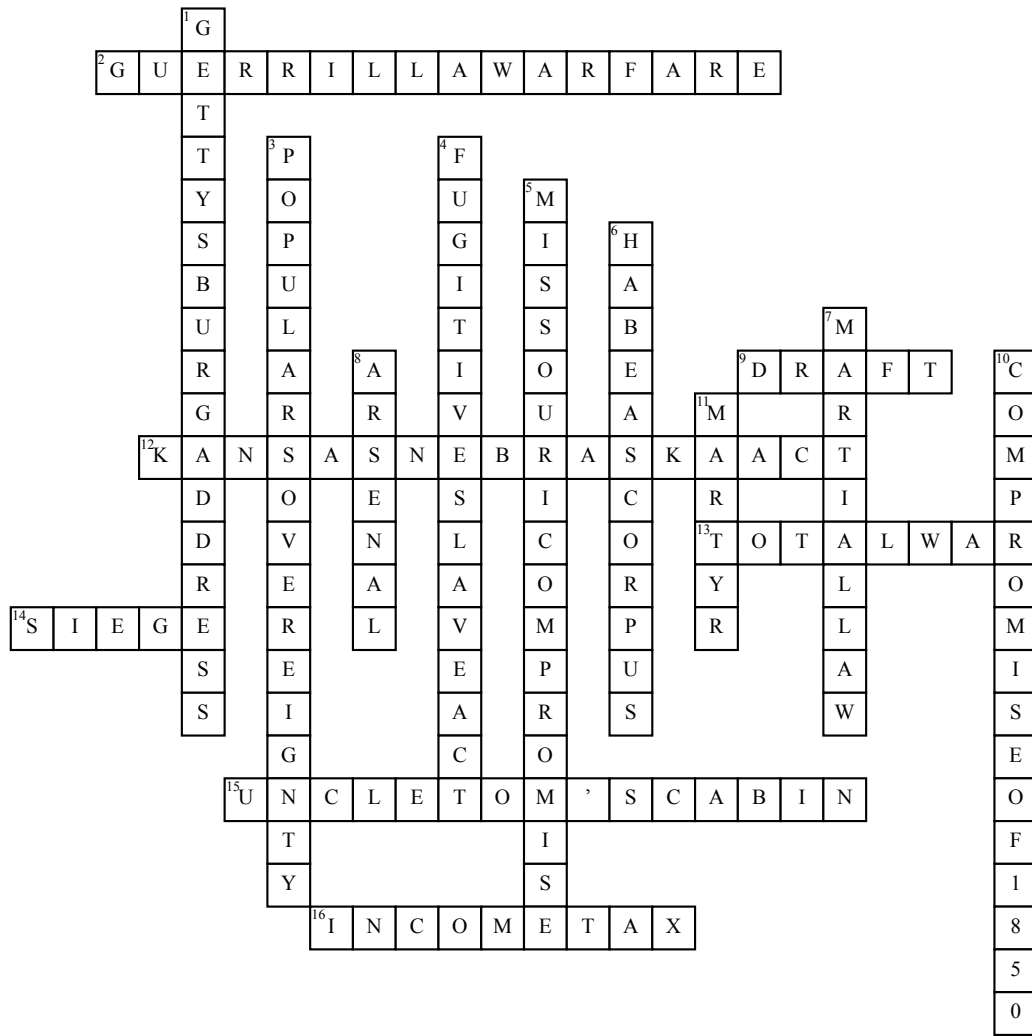


Chapter 8 History Crossword Puzzle
