


Pregnancy Vocabulary

4. birth refers to when a baby is born too early, before 37 weeks of pregnancy. Important growth and development occur throughout pregnancy-especially in the final months and weeks
7. is a eukaryotic cell formed by a fertilization event between two gametes
9. a flattened circular organ in the uterus of pregnant eutherian mammals, nourishing and maintaining the fetus through the umbilical cord
10. an unborn or unhatched offspring in the process of development
11. a mammalian blastula in which some differentiation of cells has occurred

1. sound or other vibrations having an ultrasonic frequency, particularly as used in medical imaging
2. an unborn offspring of a mammal, in particular an unborn human baby more than eight weeks after conception
3. a flexible cordlike structure containing blood vessels and attaching a human or other mammalian fetus to the placenta during gestation.
5. the fluid-filled sac that contains and protects a fetus in the womb.
6. the birth of an infant that has died in the womb
8. a period of three months, especially as a division of the duration of pregnancy.
