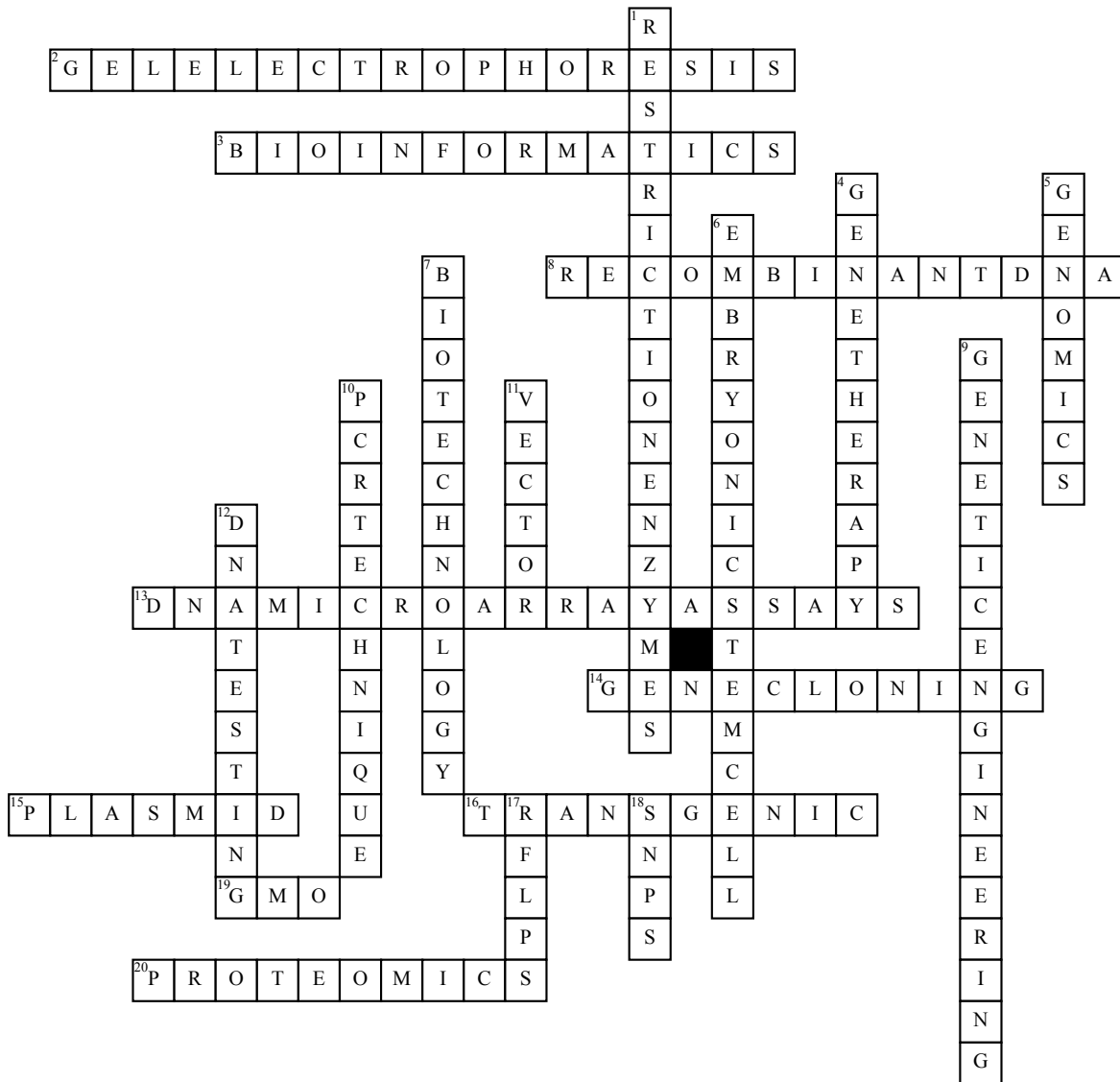

2. Used to separate DNA using an electrical current  
 3. The application of computational methods to the storage and analysis of biological data

 14. Process of producing multiple copies of specific segments of DNA  
 15. Small, circular extra-chromosomal loop of DNA found in prokaryotes  
 16. Of, relating to, or denoting an organism that contains genetic material into which DNA from an unrelated organism has been artificially introduced

19. An organism that has acquired by artificial means one or more genes from another species

1. Used to cut strands of DNA at specific locations  
 4. The introduction of genes into an afflicted individual for therapeutic purposes  
 5. The study of whole sets of genes and their interactions  
 6. An undifferentiated cell that can reproduce indefinitely and has the ability to differentiate into a specialized cell
