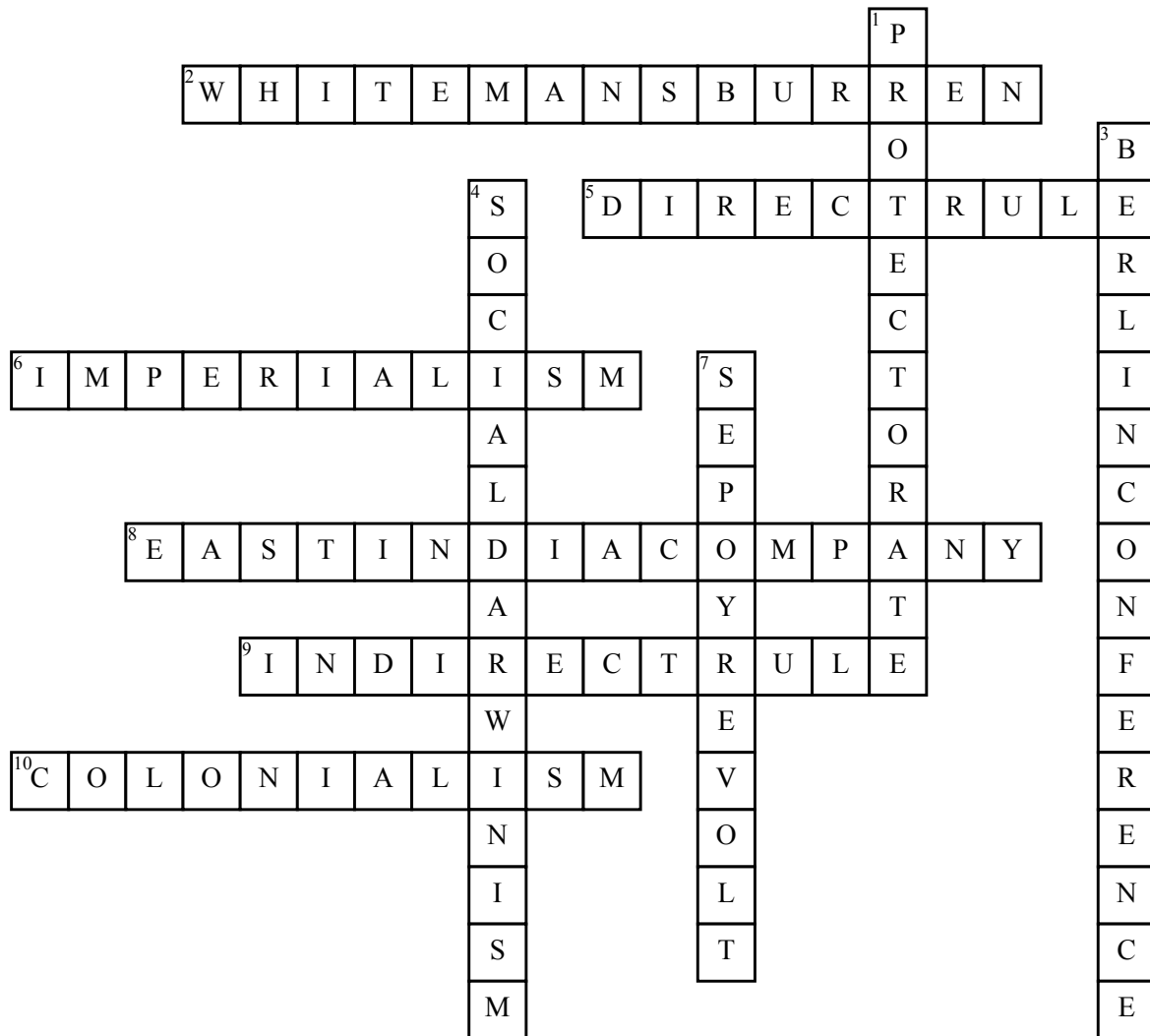


Imperialism Crossword Bradley Tonges

1. A political unit that depends on another government for its protection.
3. A conference that European countries met at in 1884 and 1885 to divide land in East Africa.
4. Theory used by Western nations in the late nineteenth century to justify their dominance; it was based on Charles Darwin's theory of natural selection, "the survival of the fittest", and applied to modern human activities.
7. A rebellious act that occurred because of the growing Indian distrust of the British. Also referred to as the Sepoy Mutiny, First War of Independence, and the Great Rebellion, it was primarily over the rumor that the new rifle cartridges were greased with cow and pig fat, which were sacred animals for the Hindus and Muslims.
