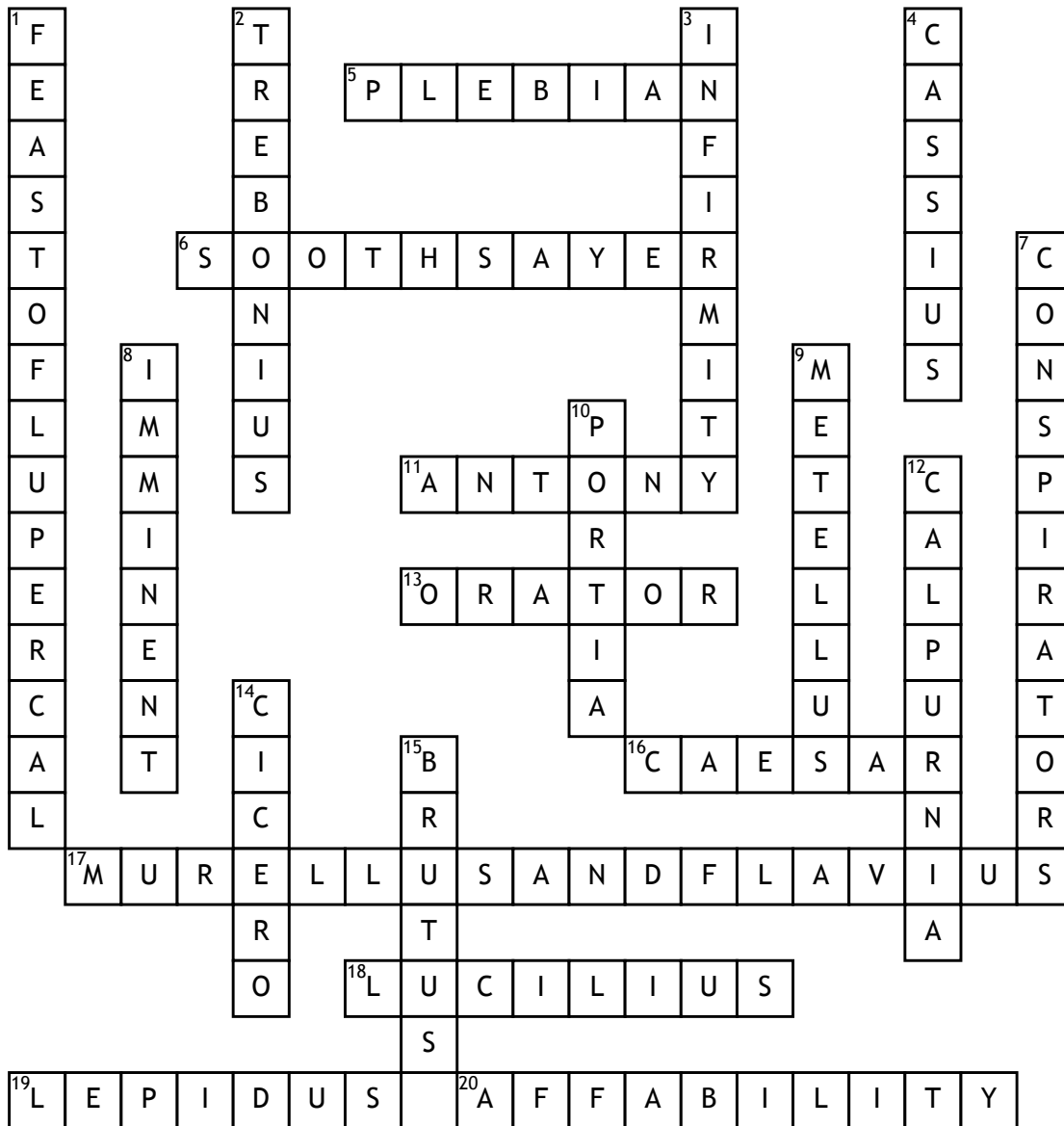


The tragedy of julius caesar
